AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGULATION AND PROHIBITION OF ARBITRARY CHANGE OF NAME IN NIGERIA AND FOR RELATED MATTERS

Sponsored by Hon. Gyang Istifanus Dung Commencement ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows-1 1. A person shall not change his or her surname, forename and any Change of Surname. 2 forename or any other name either by adding, substituting or reducing the number of names other name 3 in his birth certificate or any certificate issued by the Commission except in 4 accordance with this Bill. 5 2. No person shall be allowed to change his surname, forename Prohibition of change of surname, forename 6 and any other name together or at separate times throughout his life time and any other name 7 such that such change shall give the person a totally new identity provided 8 such change shall only be an addition to the already existing surname, 9 forename and any other name. 10 3. 		EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to provide for the regulation and prohibition of arbitrary change of name and in exceptional cases provide for the procedure to change name in Nigeria, offences and penalties for violation.
