AN ACT TO ENSURE THE SAFE TRANSPORTATION OF GLASS-BOTTLED DRINKS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES ON ROADS AND HIGHWAYS AND FOR RELATED MATTERS

Commencement ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows-PART I - OBJECTIVES 1 1. The objectives of this Act are to: Objectives 2 (a) Make individuals and companies liable for broken glass bottles 3 that deface and obstruct highways and roads in the event of a road accident; 4 (b) Ensure that vehicles conveying bottled drinks packed in glass 5 are constructed in a manner to ensure that broken glass shall not be left on the 6 highway without penalty in the event of a road accident. 7 PART II - APPLICATION OF THE ACT 8 2. This Act shall apply to individuals and corporate bodies 9 Application of the provision of conveying glass-bottled drinks and any other chemical substance packed in this Act 10 glass that are in transit on roads and highways. 11 PART III - SAFETY SPECIFICATION 12 3.-(1) Individuals and Companies conveying any drink, beverage 13 Safety Specification or chemical substance packed in glass bottles, shall ensure that the cabin, 14 carriage or container attached to the truck is constructed in such a way that 15 the cabin, carriage or container is completely sealed up to prevent any glass 16 bottle, broken or in whole, from spilling out of the vehicle, either in motion 17 or in the event of an accident, thereby causing obstruction to other road 18 19 users. (2) All parts of a vehicle transporting goods packed in glass shall be 20

1 of solid metal, sound material and free from all construction defects. 2 (3) The cab, cabin or trailer body of any vehicle conveying products 3 packed in glass shall be sealed up and shall not exceed 3.5 metres in height 4 maximum. 5 **PROHIBITION** 4. This Bill Prohibits-6 7 (1) Transporting glass-bottled drinks and substances in an open cab or 8 cabin. 9 (2) Littering highways and roads with glass, whether broken or 10 whole. 11 OFFENCES AND PENALTIES 12 5.-(1) Any company who authorises his agent to drive a vehicle or truck conveying glass-bottled drinks and substances without ensuring that the 13 14 truck's cabin is sound and free from defects shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to a fine of one million naira (N1,000,000). 15 16 (2) Any company who authorises his agent to drive a truck conveying 17 glass-bottled drinks and substances without ensuring that the truck has an enclosed body of 3.5 metres height maximum shall be liable to a fine of two 18 million naira (N2,000,000). 19 20 (3) Any company who causes glass broken or whole to litter on the 21 road or highway without immediately removing the glass, shall be guilty of an 22 offence and shall be liable to a fine of three million naira (N3,000,000). 23 (4) Any driver who drives a truck conveying glass-bottled drinks and 24 substances without ensuring that the truck's cabin is sound and free from defects, shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to a fine of five hundred 26 thousand naira (N500,000) or to imprisonment of not less than six (6) months 27 or both. 28 (5) Any driver who drives a truck conveying glass-bottled drinks and 29 substances without ensuring that the truck has an enclosed body of 3.5 metres height maximum shall be guilty of an offence shall be liable to a fine of five 30
