AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE SECURITY SERVICES WELFARE INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION TO PROVIDE AMONG OTHER THINGS, MANAGEMENT AND REVIEW THE STATE OF WELFARE INFRASTRUCTURE OF THE SECURITY SERVICES; AND FOR CONNECTED PURPOSES

**PURPOSES** Sponsored by Hon. Joan Onyemaechi Mrakpor Commencement BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: 1. -(1) There is established a body to be known as the Security Services Welfare Infrastructure Development Commission (in this Act/referred to as "the Commission") 3 Establishment of 2. -(1) The Commission shall be a body corporate with perpetual 4 the Security Services Welfare succession, and a common seal and may sue and be sued in its corporate Infrastructure Development Commission 6 name. 3.-(1) The management of the Commission shall vest in the Management of the Commission following who shall be appointed by the President subject to the confirmation by the Senate: 9 (a) a Chairman; and 10 (b) ten other Commissioners. 11 (2) The President shall appoint at least one Commissioner from: 12 (a) each of the Security Services; and 13 (b) a professional from outside the Security Services. 14 (3) The Chairman shall be a person who has: 15 (a) attained the rank of at least a Brigadier-General or its 16 equivalent; and 17 (b) retired from active service in any of the security services. 18

18	person not being a body corporate, would not be required to be under seal
19	may be made or executed on behalf of the Commission by the Secretary or
20	any person generally or specifically authorised by the Commission to act for
21	that purpose.
22	(3) A document purporting to be duly executed under the seal of the
23	Commission shall be received in evidence and shall, unless and until the
24	contrary is proved, be presumed to be so executed.
25	5. The validity of any proceedings of the Commission or of a
26	committee shall not be adversely affected by:
27	(a) a vacancy in the membership of the Commission or committee;
28	(b) a defect in the appointment of a member of the Commission or
29	committee; or
30	(c) a reason that a person not entitled to do so took part in the

proceedings of the Commission or committee.

## EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to Establish the Security Services Welfare Infrastructure Development Commission to provide for the Functions and Powers of the Commission; to empower the Commission to Provide, Manage and Review the State of Welfare Infrastructure of the Security Services.
