ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria-1. The National Business and Technical Education Board Act Cap 1 N12, Laws of the Federation of Nigeria 2004 (in this Bill referred to as "the 2 Principal Act") is amended as set out in this Bill. 3 2. The Principal Act is amended by inserting, after the existing 4 Section "3" Section "3A"-5 (1) There is established a steering committee for centralization of 6 the management of the National Business and Technical Examinations, the 7 Senior School Certificate Examination and the Unified Tertiary 8 9 Matriculation Examinations. (2) The committee shall consist of-10 (a) Permanent Secretary, Federal Ministry of Education who shall 11 be the Chairman of the committee; 12 (b) a representative of the National Business and Technical 13

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend the National Business and Technical Education Board Act Cap N12, Laws of the Federation of Nigeria 2004, to establish a steering committee to be vested with the responsibility of centralizing management of the National Business and Technical Examinations (NABTE), the Senior School Certificate Examination (SSCE) and the Unified Tertiary Matriculation Examinations (UTME) under a single ICT platform, to reduce the cost of taking the examinations.
