The National Examination Council (NECO) (Establishment) Act Cap N37 Laws of the Federation of Nigeria 2004 (in this Bill referred to 2 as "the Principal Act") is amended as set out in this Bill. 3 4 2. The Principal Act is amended by inserting, after the existing 5 Section "26" Section "26A"-6 (1) There is established a steering committee for centralization of the management of the Senior School Certificate Examination, the Unified 7 Tertiary and Matriculation Examinations and the National Business and 8 9 Technical Examination. (2) The committee shall consist of 10 (a) Permanent Secretary, Federal Ministry of Education who shall 11 be the Chairman of the committee; 12 (b) A representative of the National Examinations Council, not 13 14 below the rank of a Director;

This Bill seeks to An Act to Amend the National Examinations Council (NECO) (Establishment) Act Cap N37 Laws of the Federation of Nigeria 2004, to establish a steering committee to be vested with the responsibility of centralizing management of the Senior School Certificate Examination (SSCE), the Unified Tertiary Matriculation Examinations (UTME) and the National Business and Technical Examinations (NABTE) under a single ICT platform, to reduce the cost of taking the examinations.
