This Bill seeks to amend the Code of Conduct Bureau and Tribunal Act Cap. C15 LFN 2004 to provide for the creation of divisions of the Code of Conduct Tribunal in the geo-political zones in Nigeria in order to ensure maintenance of high standard of morality, fast dispensation of justice, and accountability in the conduct of holders of public offices at the state and zonal levels in the country.
