This Bill may be cited as Public Officers Protection Act Citation 11 (Amendment) Bill. 2017. 12 EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM This Bill seeks to amend the Public Officers Protection Act. Cap P41, LFN 2004 to extend the time within which actions may be commenced against public officers from three months to one year.
