AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE NIGERIA POLICE REFORM TRUST FUND AND FOR RELATED MATTERS, 2017

ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: PART 1 - OBJECTIVE, SCOPE AND DURATION 1 1. The objective of this Act is to provide a legal framework for Objective 2 management and control of the special intervention fund established under 3 section 3 of this Act for training and retraining of personnel of the Nigeria Police Force and for the provision of equipment and related facilities for the 5 enhancement of the skills of the personnel of the Nigeria Police in the handling of operational equipment and machineries. 7 2.-(1) The Trust Fund established under section 3 of this Act covers Scope and 8. duration all personnel of the Nigeria Police Force, including its auxiliary staff in 9 Nigeria and abroad for the overall improvement and efficiency in the 10 discharge of their duties and responsibilities. 11 (2) The Trust Fund is to operate for a period of six years from the 12 commencement of this Act and shall at the expiration of that period cease to 13 exist unless extended for any further period by an act of the National 14 Assembly. 15 PART II - ESTABLISHMENT, PURPOSE AND MANAGEMENT OF THE 16 NIGERIA POLICE REFORM TRUST FUND 17 3.-(1) There is established a fund to be known as the Nigeria Police Establishment 18 of the Nigeria Police Reform Reform Trust Fund (in this Act referred to as "the Trust Fund"). 19 Trust Fund (2) The Trust Fund: 20 (a) is a body corporate with a common seal; and

24	SUPPLEMENTARY PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE BOARD PROCEEDINGS
. 25	1. Subject to the provisions of this Act and section 27 of the
26	Interpretation Act, the Board may make standing orders regulating its
27	proceedings or those of its committee.
28	2. The quorum of the Board shall be the Chairman and ten other
29	members, three of whom shall be from the private sector and the quorum of
30	any committee shall be determined by the Board.

1	3. The Board shall meet not less than four times in each year and
2	subject thereto the Board shall meet whenever it is summoned by the
3	Chairman, or if the Chairman is required to do so by notice given to him by not
4	less than ten members of the Board, he shall summon a meeting of the Board to
5	be held within fourteen days from the date on which the notice was given.
6	4. At any meeting of the Board, the Chairman shall preside but in his
7	absence, the members present at the meeting shall appoint one of their
8	members to preside at the meeting.
9	5. Where the Board desires to obtain the advice of any person on a
10	particular matter, the Board may co-opt the person to the Board for such period
1	as it thinks fit, but a person who is in attendance by virtue of this sub-paragraph
12	is not entitled to vote at any meeting of the Board and does not count towards a
13	quorum.
4	6. All members of the Board shall have equal rights and privileges,
15	and where there is equality in vote, the Chairman shall have a casting vote.
6	Committees
7	7. The Board may appoint such number of committees to carry out,
8	on behalf of the Board such of its functions as the Board may, from time to time,
9	determine.
20	8. A committee appointed under paragraph 7 of this schedule shall
1	consists of such number of persons (not necessarily members of the Board) as
2	may be determined by the Board, and the person, other than a member of the
3	Board, shall hold office on the committee in accordance with the terms of his
4	appointment.
5	9. A decision of a committee of the Board shall be of no effect until it
6	is confirmed and or ratified by the Board.
7	Miscellaneous
8	10. The fixing of the seal of the Fund shall be authenticated by the
9	signature of the Chairman or of any other person authorized generally or
0	specially to act for that purpose by the Board

 Any contract or instrument made or executed by a person not
being a body corporate, that would not be required to be under seal may be
made or executed on behalf of the Board by the Chairman or any person
generally or specifically authorized to act for that purpose by the Board.

- 12. Any document purporting to be a document duly executed under the seal of the Trust Fund shall be received in evidence and shall, unless, and until the contrary is proved, be presumed to be so executed.
- 13. The validity of any proceeding of the Board or of a committee thereof shall not be adversely affected by any vacancy in the membership of the Board or committee, or by any defect in the appointment of a member of the Board or of a committee, or by reason that a person not entitled to do so took part in the proceedings of the Board or committee.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to establish the Nigeria Police Reform Trust Fund to operate for a period of six years, to among other things, provide funds for the training and retraining of the personnel of the Nigeria Police Force, provide equipment and machineries to improve the general welfare of the personnel of the Nigeria Police Force and enhance their preparedness to effectively discharge their constitutional responsibility of protecting life and property of the people of Nigeria.
