## A BILL

## FOR

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE NATIONAL CENTER FOR RESEARCH AND PRODUCTION OF SNAKE VACCINES IN NIGERIA AND FOR RELATED MATTERS, 2017

ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: 1. There is hereby established the National Center for Research 1 and Production of Snake Vaccines (in this Act referred to as "the Center"). 2 2. The Center shall have the following as functions: (a) to provide national leadership in snake research, Production of 5 Vaccines: (b) to guide scientific improvements to snake prevention, 6 7 treatment and care; (c) to coordinate and liaise between the wide range of groups and 9 health care providers with an interest in Snake; 10 (d) to make recommendations to the Government about snake 11 policy and priorities; 12 (e) to oversee a dedicated budget for research into snake; 13 (f) to assist with the implementation of Government policies and 14 programs in snake control; (g) to provide financial assistance, out of money appropriated by 15 the National Assembly, for research and treatment as mentioned in 16 paragraph (e) and for the implementation of polices and programs 17 18 mentioned in paragraph (f). 19 (2) The Center may carry out such other activities as are necessary

6	within 28 days from the date on which the notice is given.
7	(3) Any notice given under sub-paragraph (2) of this paragraph shall
8	state the matters to be discussed at the special meeting and any matter not so
9	stated shall not be discussed at the meeting.
10	[4) At every meeting of the Board, the chairman shall preside and in
11	his absence the members present shall appoint one of their numbers to preside
12	at that meeting.

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- (4) Any document purporting to be document duly executed under the seal of the Board shall be received in evidence and shall, unless the contrary is proved, be presumed to be so executed.
- 7. Members of the Board who are not public officers shall be paid out of the money at the disposal of the Board such traveling and other allowances, in accordance with such scales as may be approved, from time to time, by the Minister.
- 8. Any member of the Board or a committee thereof who has a personal interest in any contract or arrangement entered into or purposed to be considered by the Board or a committee thereof shall forthwith disclose his interest to the Board or committee and shall not vote on any question relating to such contract or arrangement.

## EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The Bill seeks to provide for the establishment of the National Center for Research and Production of Snake Vaccines to research into Snake and to provide treatment to patients in Nigeria.

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
