# A BILL

#### FOR

AN ACT TO AMEND THE NIGERIAN COMMUNICATIONS ACT NO 19, 2003 TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT OF ALL MONIES RECEIVED BY THE COMMISSION INTO THE FEDERATION ACCOUNT IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 162 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF NIGERIA 1999 (AS AMENDED)

Sponsored by Hon. Gyang Istifanus Dung Commencement ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: 1. The Nigerian Communications Act No 19, 2003 (in this Bill 1 Amendment of Act No. 19, 2003 referred to as "the Principal Act") is amended as set out in this Bill. 2 2. Section 17 of the Principal Act is amended by substituting for 3 Amendment of Section 17 the existing section 17, a new section 17: 4 "17. (1) The Funds of the Commission shall consist of: 5 (a) such funds as budgetary allocations, trust funds, subventions, 6 7 grants-in-aid and loans as may, from time to time, be made by the Federal Government: 8 (b) such sums or property which may, from time to time by way of 9 loans or grants and gifts accrue to the Commission form any other 10 Government, non-governmental bodies or individuals; and 11 (c) other monies received by the Commission which may in any 12 13 way, become payable to or vested in the Commission by way of revenues, fees, levies, taxes, penalties, gifts, grants-in-aid, testamentary disposition 14 and all other assets that may from time to time accrue to the Commission." 15 (2) All monies received by or on behalf of the Commission shall be 16 receipted and shall be paid into the Federation Account within 24 hours of 17 receipt or the next working day. 18

## EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend the Nigerian Communications Act No 19, 2003 to provide for the payment of all monies received by the Commission into the Federation Account in accordance with Section 162 of the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria 1999 (as amended).
