BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follow-

PART I - ESTABLISHMENT, BOARD MEMBERSHIP, ETC

1 1.-(1) There is hereby established for the Federal Republic of Nigeria an institution known as Federal Polytechnic Dukku, Gombe State 2 . for the purpose of providing qualitative education in Sciences, Arts and 3 other Technical knowledge and Research and Training and for other related 4 matters connected therewith; herein this bill referred to as the 'institution or 5: institute' as the case may be.

- (2) The Institution shall be a body with the status of a public study and research facility, corporate with perpetual succession and a common seal, so that the institution may:
- (a) Sue and be sued in its corporate name and
- (b) Hold, acquire and dispose of any properly or interest in property, moveable or îmnjoveable.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to provide for the establishment of Federal Polytechnic Dukku, Gombe State for the purpose of providing qualitative education in Sciences, Arts and other Technical knowledge and Research and Training.
