### EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend the National Youth Service Corps Act Cap. N84 Laws of the Federation of Nigeria 2004, to among other things make participation in the service corps scheme optional in order to minimize cost of maintaining the scheme and to allow only those graduates that are genuinely interested to participate.
