AN ACT TO AMEND THE EDUCATION (NATIONAL MINIMUM STANDARDS AND ESTABLISHMENT OF INSTITUTIONS) ACT CAP E36 LAWS OF THE FEDERATION OF NIGERIA 2004 TO EXPRESSLY PROVIDE THAT THE APPROPRIATE AUTHORITY (NATIONAL UNIVERSITIES COMMISSION, NATIONAL BOARD FOR TECHNICAL EDUCATION, NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR COLLEGES OF EDUCATION) SHALL HAVE POWER TO ISSUE GUIDELINES REGULATING THE CONDITION OF SERVICE AND PROCEDURE FOR THE ENGAGEMENT OF ACADEMIC STAFF ON PART TIME BASIS OR VISITING LECTURESHIP.

ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows:

- 1 **1.** Section 24 Subsection (1) of the Education (National Minimum
2 Standards and Establishment of Institutions) Act CAP E3 Laws of the
3 Federation of Nigeria as amended by inserting a new paragraph, after
4 existing paragraph (c) thus:
5 “(cc) the condition of service (including maximum lecturer time in
6 an academic year) and the procedure for the engagement of academic staff
7 on part time basis or visiting lectureship”.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This bill seeks to amend the Education (National Minimum Standards and Establishment of Institutions) Act CAP E3 Laws of the Federation of Nigeria 2004 (as amended), to expressly provide that the appropriate authority (National Universities Commission, National Board for Technical Education, Nation Commission for Colleges of Education) shall have power to issue guidelines regulating the condition of service and the procedure for the engagement of academic staff on part time basis or visiting lectureship by higher education institutions in Nigeria.
