ľ Commencement ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria: PART I - ESTABLISHMENT, MEMBERSHIP, ETC. 1.-(1) There is hereby established for the Federal Capital Territory 1 Establishment Abuja ("FCT"), an Authority, to be known as the FCT Metropolitan 2 Management Council ("the Council"), which shall be responsible for the 3 efficient running and operation of Municipal Services within the FCT. 4 (2) The Authority shall be a body corporate with perpetual 5 succession and a common seal and may: 6 (a) sue and be sued in its corporate name; and 7 (b) hold, acquire and dispose of any property or interest in property, 8 9 moveable or immovable. 2.-(1) The governing body of the Council shall be a Board of 10 Board of Directors Directors referred to in this Act as "the Board". 11 (2) The Board shall consist of: 12 (a) the Minister, who shall be the Chairman; 13 (b) the Executive Secretary of the FCDA, who shall be the Vice 14 Chairman; 15 (c) the Co-ordinator, who shall be a full time member of the Board; 16 (d) five other members appointed by the Minister, who shall be 17

1	persons with cognate experience in environmental and or municipal matters.
2	(3) All members of the Board, other than the Co-ordinator shall be
3	part-time members.
4	(4) There shall be paid to the Members of the Board such
5	remuneration as the minister may determine.
6	(5) Members appointed to the Board pursuant to paragraph (d) or
7	subsection (2) shall hold office for a period of four years renewable once for a
8	further period of four years only, provided however that:
9	(a) any Member may resign his appointment at any time by notice in
10	writing under his hand addressed to the Minister;
11	(b) if a Member dies or resigns or otherwise vacates his office before
12	the expiration of the term for which he is appointed, a fit and proper person
13	shall be appointed for the remainder of the term of office of that Member, and
14	that the successor shall represent the same interest and shall be appointed by
15	the Minister;
16	(c) a Member may be removed from office by the Minister if he is
17	satisfied that it is not in the interest of the Councilor the interest of the public
18	that the Member should continue in office.
19	(6) The provisions of the Second Schedule to this Act shall have effect
20	with respect to the proceedings of the Authority and other matters mentioned
21	therein.
22	3(1) The following operational departments are hereby established
23	for the Council:
24	(a) Department of Parks and Recreation;
25	(b) Department of Development Control;
26	(c) Department of Facilities Maintenance and Management;
27	(d) Department of Road Traffic Services;
28	(e) Department of Urban Affairs; and
29	(2) The functions, as well as the subdivisions of each of the
30	departments established in subsection (1) above, shall be as set out in the First

2	(3) The departments of the Council shall report to the Director-	
3	General, who shall oversee their operations on a day-to-day basis.	
4	(4) For the effective conduct of the functions of the Council, the	
5	Minister may issue regulations prescribing additional departments for the	
6	Councilor altering the departments listed in subsection (1) of this section in	
7	any manner whatsoever.	
8	(5) Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, the Board shall	
9	have power to set up any committee to assist in the performance of its duties	
10	and functions under this Act.	
11	(6) A committee set up under subsection (5) of this section shall	
12	consist of such number of persons as may be determined by the Board, and a	
13	member of such committee shall hold office in the committee in accordance	
14	with the terms of his appointment.	
15	(7) A decision of any such committee shall not be effective unless	
16	ratified by the Board.	
17	PART II - FUNCTIONS AND POWERS	
18	4(1) Subject to and without prejudice to the provisions of the	Functions
19	Federal Capital Territory Act, the Council shall be responsible for the	
20	following functions within the FCT:	٠
21	(a) land use and control of development in the Territory, including	
22	processing and approval of building plans for development and monitoring	
23	and control of physical development;	
24	(b) design, control and provision of parks, gardens and recreational	
25	facilities and maintenance thereof;	
26	(c) fire prevention and control;	
27	(d) emergency preparedness and response;	
28	(e) control of advertisements, including issuance of permits for	
29	municipal, advertisements, bill boards, signboards, etc.;	
30	(f) street, naming and house numbering;	

1	(g) management of markets within the metropolis, and
2	
3	(2) In discharging its general responsibility under subsection (1)
4	above, the Council shall:
5	(a) prepare plans for the management of all public facilities within the
6	FCT;
7	(b) in collaboration with the Federal Capital Development Authority.
8	manage, protect, maintain and improve public infrastructure and facilities and
9	all public buildings within the FCT that are necessary for the discharge of its
10	functions;
11	(c) levy user charges in connection with the provision of its services
12	and collect such charges or any other tariff that are necessary for the discharge
13	of its functions; and
14	(d) enter into agreement with any person for the supply, construction,
15	manufacture, maintenance or repair of any property whether movable or
16	immovable, which is necessary or appropriate for the purpose of the Council.
17	(3) The Minister may issue regulations adding to, deleting from or
18	altering in any manner whatsoever, the functions of the Council as listed in
19	subsection (1) of this section.
20	5(1) The Council shall have the power to:
21	(a) do all things which by this Act or any other enactment are required
22	or permitted to be done by the Council;
23	(b) monitor any matter that may affect the functions of the Council;
24	(c) do anything that will ensure the advancement of the skills of
25	employees of the Authority or the equipment of the Council including the
26	provision of training facilities, education and general research.
27	(d) make, draw, accept or endorse negotiable instruments; and
28	(e) do such other acts as may appear to it reasonable, advantageous or
29	convenient, necessary or expedient for the full discharge of its functions under
30	this Act, either alone or in collaboration with any other person.

General Powers

1	(2) Subject to any limitation imposed by law, the Council may	
2	delegate any of its powers to any Member or official of [he Authority and	
3	authorize any such Member or official to perform any of its functions.	
4	6. Subject to the approval of the Minister, the Council may from	Power to borroy
5	time to time, borrow by way of overdraft or otherwise, such sums as it may	
6	require for the effective discharge of its functions under this Act.	
7	7(1) The Council may accept any gift, grant or donation of land,	Power to accept
8	money or other property from any person upon such terms and conditions	Gifts
9	(acceptable to the Council), if any, as may be specified by the person making	
10	the gift or donation.	
11	(2) The Council shall not accept any gift or donation if the	
12	conditions attached thereto by the person making the gift or donation are	
13	inconsistent with the functions of the Council.	
14	PAR'T III - STAFF OF THE AUTHORITY	
15	8(1) The President shall, upon the recommendation of the	Director-General
16	Minister, appoint a Director-General as the Chief Executive Officer of the	
17	Council.	
18	(2) The Director-General shall hold office for the term specified in	
19	subsection (5) of section 2 of this Act provided that, the said term may be	
20	renewed for one or more term if the Minister deems it fit.	
21	(3) The Director-General shall be responsible for the day-to-day	
22	administration of the Council, keeping the books and records of the Council	
23	and the execution of the policy and practice of the Authority and shall be	
24	subject to the supervision and control of the Board.	
25	(4) The Director-General shall hold office on such terms as to	
26	emoluments and otherwise as may be specified in his letter of appointment.	
27	9(1) The Council may from time to time, appoint such other	Staff of the
28	employees as it may deem necessary, to assist the Council in the	Council
29	performance of its functions under this Act and without prejudice to the	
30	generality of the foregoing, there shall be for each of the boards and	

	1	departments of the Council created under this Act, a Director who shall report
	2	to the Director-General.
	3	(2) The staff of the Council appointed under subsection (1) of this
	4	section shall be appointed upon such terms and conditions of service as the
	5	Council may, after consultation with the FCT Public Service Commission,
	6	determine:
	7	PROVIDED that the Minister may apply to the President for approval
	8	of the application to the staff of the Council, of such improved and or preferred
	9	terms and conditions of service as may be necessary.
	10	(3) The power of the Council under subsection (1) of this section shall
	11	include the power to:
	12	(a) promote and control the staff of the Council as may appear to the
	13	Council necessary or expedient; and
	14	(b) dismiss, terminate, consider the resignation or withdrawal of
	15	appointment and exercise disciplinary control over the staff of the Council,
	16	other than the Director-General.
	17	(4) The Council may delegate to the Director-General, generally or
	18	specifically, the power to appoint s categories of staff of the Council as the
	19	Council may from time to time specify.
	20	(5) The staff of the Council shall be Public Officers of the FCT, as
	21	defined in the FCT Public Service Commission Act.
	22	(6) The Council may engage such consultants and advisers as it may
	23	require for the effective discharge its functions.
aff Regulations	24	10(I) The Council may, subject to the provisions of this Act and in
	25	consultation with FCT Public Service Commission, make staff regulations
	26	relating generally to the conditions of service of its employ and without
	27	prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, such regulations may provide for:
	28	(a) the appointment, promotion and disciplinary control (including
	29	dismissal) of the employees of Council; and

1	(b) appeals by employees against dismissal on other disciplinary	
2	measures.	
3	(2) Pending the release of the regulations described in subsection	
4	(1) of this section, the employment the staff of the Council shall be governed	
5	by the terms and conditions generally applicable to office of the public	
6	service of the FCT.	
7	(3) Staff regulations issued by the Council under subsection (1) of	
8	this section shall not have effect until approved by the Minister and	
9	published in the Gazette.	
10	PART IV - FINANCIAL PROVISIONS	
11	11(1) The Council shall establish and maintain a fund ("the	Fund of the
12	Fund") which shall consist of:	Council
13	(a) the initial take-off grant from the FCT Administration;	
14	(b) such sums as may be provided by the Federal Capital	
15	Development Authority by way of annual subventions or otherwise;	
16	(c) fees, fines and levies charged by the Council;	
17	(d) income from any investments or other property acquired by or	
18	vested in the Council;	
19	(e) all other sums (whether as tariff or as user charges, or	
20	otherwise) or other property which may in any manner become payable to or	
21	vested in the Council in respect of its powers and duties or of any incidental	,
22	matter under this Law or by virtue of the provisions of any other Law;	
23	(f) subject to section 7 of this Act, all other sums accruing to the	
24	Council by way of grants, gifts, testamentary dispositions, endowments,	
25	bequests and donations made to the Council; and	
26	(g) such other sum as may accrue from time to time to the Council.	
27	(2) The Fund shall be managed in accordance with rules prescribed	
28	by the Minister, provided the rules shall contain provisions:	
29	(a) specifying the manner in which the assets of the fund are to be	
30	held:	

	1	(b) regulating payments into the Fund and the matters to which the
	2	assets of the Fund may be applied; and
	3	(c) requiring the keeping of proper accounts and records for the
	4	purpose of the Fund in such form as may be prescribed.
	5	(3) The Council shall operate account with banks approved by the
	6	Minister and the signatories to the account shall either be the Director-General
	7	or his designated representative and the Head of accounts or any person duly
	8	authorized by the Board in that behalf.
Annual estimates,	9	12(1) The Council shall, not later than 30 September in each year,
accounts and audits	10	submit to the Minister an estimate of its expenditure and income (including
	11	estimates of expected payments into the Fund) during the next succeeding year.
	12	(2) The Council shall keep proper accounts in a form which conforms
	13	to accepted accounting standards, and proper records in relation thereto and the
	14	accounts shall be audited as provided in subsection (3) of this section.
	15	(3) The accounts of the Council shall be audited at the end of each
	16	calendar year by auditors appointed by the FCT Administration from the list
	17	and in accordance with the Financial Guidelines and the fees of the auditors
	18	and the expenses for the audit generally shall be paid from the Fund.
Annual reports	19	13. The Council shall, not later than 30 June in each year, submit to
	20	the Minister, a report on the activities of the Authority and its administration
	21	during the immediately preceding year and shall include in the report the
·	22	audited accounts of the Council and the auditors' report thereon.
	23	PART V - REGULATIONS AND SUPPLEMENTARY PROVISIONS

	25	of this Act and the due administration thereof.
	26	(2) Without prejudice to the generality of subsection (1) of this
	27	section, the Minister may prescribe rates, tariffs and user charges from time to
