AN ACT TO AMEND THE COMPULSORY, FREE UNIVERSAL BASIC
EDUCATION ACT, 2004 AND FOR RELATED MATTERS 2017

ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of
Nigeria as follows:

1. The Compulsory, Free Universal Basic Education Act 2004 (in
this Bill referred to as the "Principal Act") is amended as set out in this Bill.

2. The Principal Act is hereby amended in Section 11 by inserting
a new Sub Section 2 (a) to read as follows:

Amendment of
Section 11

"such state shall ensure that teachers who are eligible for
promotion are duly considered and promoted."

3. The principal Act is hereby amended in Section 11 by inserting
a new Sub Section 2 (b) as follows:

Amendment of
Section 11

"Salary increment for teachers shall also be implemented by such
state to deserving teachers."

4. This Bill may be cited as the Compulsory, Free Universal Basic
Education Act (Amendment Bill) 2017.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to provide for An Act to Amend the Compulsory, Free

teachers by ensuring that before states access the Federal Government grant,
the states are required to fulfill their obligations to teachers by ensuring that
eligible teachers due for promotion and salary increment are promptly paid
their entitlements to encourage efficiency.
