AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT NATIONAL RANCHES COMMISSION FOR THE REGULATION, MANAGEMENT, PRESERVATION AND CONTROL OF RANCHES THROUGHOUT NIGERIA; AND FOR CONNECTED PURPOSES

Commencement ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: PART I - NATIONAL RANCHES COMMISSION 1 1. There is hereby established a body corporate to be known as the 2 Establishment of National Ranches National Ranches Commission (hereinafter referred to as "the Commission* 3 4 Commission"). 2. The Commission shall be a body Corporate with perpetual 5 succession and a common seal and may sue and be sued in its corporate 6. 7 name. 3.-(1) The Commission shall consist of the following members, 8 Chairman and members of the Commission 9 that is -(a) a Chairman, who by reason of his ability, experience or 10 specialized knowledge of Ranches management, would be capable of 11 making outstanding contributions to the work of the Commission; 12 (b) three representatives of the Federal Ministry of Agriculture; 13 (c) a representative of the Federal Ministry of Water Resources; 14 (d) a representative of the Federal Ministry of Health; 15 (e) a representative of the National Commission for Nomadic 16 17 Education: (i) three other persons with cognate experience representing 18

II. Any member of the Commission or a committee thereof who has a personal interest in any contract or arrangement entered into or proposed to be considered by the Commission or committee shall forthwith disclose his interest to the Commission or committee and shall not vote on any question relating to the contract or arrangement.

This Bill seeks to provide for the establishment of National Ranches Commission for the regulation, management, preservation and control of Ranches throughout Nigeria.
