AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE NATIONAL CENTRE
FOR CANCER RESEARCH AND TREATMENT AND FOR OTHER CONNECTED
PURPOSES

BE IT ENACTED by the National Assen1bly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: Establishment of the National 1. There is hereby established the National Centre for Cancer Centre for Cancer Research and Research and Treatment (in this Act referred to as "the Centre"). 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- 7.-(1) There shall be a director of the centre who shall be appointed by
 the President, on the recommendations of the Minister.
- (2) A person shall not be qualified to be appointed as a Director, unless he is a medical Doctor with at least twenty years research and administrative experience in a reputable establishment.
- (3) The Board shall not exercise any disciplinary control over the director, without the approval of the Minister.
 - (4) Subject to the provision of this Act and the control of the Board over the matters affecting finance of the centre, the director shall be the chief executive of the centre and shall be charged with the general responsibility for the management and administration of the affairs of the centre and in particular:
- (a) direct and regulate the programme of work at the centre;
- (b) promote research within and outside of the centre;
- (c) keep safe custody of all records of the centre;
- (d) demand and receive from any person attending training or courses
 at the centre fees as the Board may, from time to time determine;
 - (e) prepare and present to the Board annual and other reports on the progress of work at the centre and on the expenditure or liabilities by the centre;
 - (f) be responsible for the day to day running and management of the centre;
 - (g) exercise such powers and performs such duties as may be determined from time to time by the President.

8. -(1) There shall be for the center an administrative secretary who shall be appointed by the Board to perform such duties as may be assigned to him by the Board.

(2) Subject to Section 7 of this Act, the Board may appoint such other staff for the centre as it may determine and pay to its staff such remunerations and allowances as payable to persons on equivalent in the civil service of the federation.

7	Proceedings of the Board, etc	
8	1. Subject to this Act and Section 27 of the Interpretation Act, the	
9	Board may make standing orders to regulate the proceedings of the Board or	
10	any committee thereof.	
11	2(1) The Board shall meet not less than two times in every year	
12	for the exercise of its functions under this Act and at such times and places as	
13	the chairman may, from time to time appoint.	
14	(2) The chairman shall, if required to be so by notice in writing by	
15	not less than five other members, call a special meeting of the Board to be	
16	held within 28 days from the date on which the notice is given.	
17	(3) Any notice given under sub-paragraph (2) of this paragraph	
18	shall state the matters to be discussed at the special meeting and any matter	
19	not so stated shall not be discussed at the meeting.	
20	(4) At every meeting of the Board, the chairman shall preside and in

28	5. The Board may act notwithstanding any vacancy in its	
29	membership or any defect in the appointment of a member or the fact that	
30	any person not entitled to do so took part in the proceedings.	

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- 6. -(1) The seal of the Board shall not be used or affixed to any document, except in pursuance of a resolution duly passed at a properly constituted meeting of the Board.

 (2) The fixing of the seal of the Board shall be authenticated by the
 - (2) The fixing of the seal of the Board shall be authenticated by the signature of chairman or the director or of some other member authorized generally or specifically to act for that purpose by the Board.
 - (3) Any contract or instrument which, if made or executed by a person not being a body corporate, would be required to be under seal, may be made or executed on behalf of the Board by any person generally or specially authorised to act for that purpose by the Board.
 - (4) Any document purporting to be document duly executed under the seal of the Board shall be received in evidence and shall, unless the contrary is proved, be presumed to be so executed.
 - 7. Members of the Board who are not public officers shall be paid out of the money at the disposal of the Board such traveling and other allowances, in accordance with such scales as may be approved, from time to time, by the Minister.
 - 8. Any member of the Board or a committee thereof who has a personal interest in any contract or arrangement entered into or purposed to be considered by the Board or a committee thereof shall forthwith disclose his interest to the Board or committee and shall not vote on any question relating to such contract or arrangement.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The Bill seeks to provide for the establishment of the National Centre for Cancer research and Treatment to research into cancer and to provide treatment to patients in Nigeria.
