3	(5) If the office of the President of the Financial Crimes Court is		
4	vacant. Or if the person holding the office is for any reason unable to perform		
5	the functions of the office, then, until a person has been appointed to and		
6	assumed the functions of that office or until the person holding the office has		
7	resumed those functions, the President shall appoint the most senior Judge of		
8	the Financial Crimes Court having the qualification to be appointed as

(6) Except on the recommendation of the National Judicial
Council, an appointment pursuant to the provisions of subsection (5) of this
section shall cease to have effect after the expiration of three months from
the date of such appointment and the President shall not reappoint a person
whose appointment has lapsed.
254I-(1) Notwithstanding the generality of the provisions of this
Constitution to the contrary, the Financial Crimes Court shall have and
exercise exclusively jurisdiction in causes and matters relating to corruption
and financial crimes including offences under:
(a) Economic and Financial Crimes Commission Act
(b) Money Laundering (Prohibition) Act; and
(c) Corrupt Practices and Other Related Offences Act.
(2) the National Assembly may by an Act confer such additional
Jurisdiction on the Financial Crimes Court in respect of such other causes or
matters incidental, supplementary or related to those set out in subsection
(1) of this section.
254J-(1) For the purpose of exercising any jurisdiction conferred
upon it by the Constitution or as may be conferred by an Act of the National
Assembly, the Financial Crimes Court shall have all the powers of a High
Court.
(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (1) of this
section, the National Assembly may by law confer upon the Financial
Crimes Court powers additional to those conferred by this section as may
appear necessary or desirable for enabling the court to be more effective to
exercise its jurisdiction.
254K(1) Subject to the provisions of this Constitution and
subsection (2) of this section, no appeal shall lie from the decision of the
Financial Crimes Court to the Court of Appeal or any other court.
(2) An Appeal from the decision of the Financial Crimes Court
shall lie only as of right to the Court of Appeal only on questions of

1	fundamental right as contained in chapter 4 of this Constitution.
