EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The bill seeks to amend the Medical and Dental Practitioners Act Cap MB Laws of the Federation 2004 to amongst other things:

- (a) Make provisions for professional service delivery and effective practice by ensuring that Medical and Dental Practitioners have continuing Medical and Dental Practitioner education.
 - (b) Regulate practicing fees.
