AN ACT TO REPEAL THE FORESTRY RESEARCH INSTITUTE OF NIGERIA ACT, 1973, AND RE-ENACT THE FORESTRY RESEARCH INSTITUTE OF NIGERIA BILL, 2015; AND FOR OTHER MATTERS CONNECTED THEREWITH

NIGERIA BILL, 2015; AND FOR OTHER MATTERS CONNECTED THEREWITH Sponsored by Senator Uche Ekwunife Commencement ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: PART I - ESTABLISHMENT, ETC OF THE FORESTRY RESEARCH INSTITUTE OF NIGERIA 1.-(1) There is established a body to be known as the Forestry Establishment and Mandates of Research Institute of Nigeria in this Bill referred to as "the Institute" which 4 the Institute shall be a body corporate and charged with the performance of the following functions: (2) The broad mandates of the institute shall be; Research, Training Mandates of the Institute and Extension/Dissemination of findings. 8 (3) (a) the improvement of the genetic resources of forest trees and 9 Specific Mandates the ecosystem for economic development; 10 (b) the improvement of silvicultural practices relating to forest 11 12 trees of economic importance; (c) the mechanisation and improvement of the methods of 13 cultivating, harvesting, processing, domestication and biotechnological 14 mass production of plant stocks of forest trees of economic importance; 15 (d) research into the utilisation strategies of forest products, 16 improvement of same, inclusive of forest and processed mill-wood wastes; 17 18 (e) studying the ecology of pests and diseases of forest trees and their control; 19 (f) research into the development of agro-forestry systems for the 20

1	integration of forest trees of economic importance into farming systems in
2	different ecological zones and its socio-economic effects on the rural populati
3	ons;
4	(g) control forestry enterprises through Registration, issuance of
5	licence and permit to public or private organisations and individuals carrying
6	out businesses relating to forestry flora and fauna;
7	(h) forestry education and training; through its National and Higher
8	National Diploma awarding Tertiary Institutions namely:
9	(i) Federal College of Forestry, Ibadan;
10	(ii) Federal College of Forestry, Jos;
11	(iii) Federal College of Wildlife Management, New Bussa;
12	(iv) Federal College of Forestry Mechanization, Afaka.
13	(i) forestry extension and dissemination;
14	(j) to conduct research into the biodiversity of Nigerian forests in
15	relation to its flora and fauna;
16	(k) to conduct research into the different suitable biological materials
17	and appropriate methods of control of ecological and environmental problems
18	of the country in respect to desertification, soil erosion and deforestation;
19	inclusive of the protection of the coastal mangrove and renewable energy;
20	(l) to conduct research into the appropriate application of remote
21	sensing and geographical information systems (GIS) for climate change
22	monitoring and adaptation as well as dendrology studies;
23	(m) making suitable arrangements for the application of the results of
24	the research work as per sub-paragraph (i) above by the Federal and State
25	ministries, agencies and the private sector for the economic development of
26	Nigeria;
27	(n) co-operating with relevant Nigerian and International
28	Universities, Research Institutes and other institutions in the mobilisation of
29	the country's research potential for the task of national development and
30	dissemination of research findings for the use of policy makers at all levels and;

1	(o) doing anything and entering into any transaction which in its	
2	opinion ought to be done in the proper discharge of its functions.	
3	2(a)The Institute shall have perpetual succession and a common	Powers of the Institute
4	seal which shall be kept in such custody as the Institute may from time to	
5	time authorize;	•
6	(b) The Institute may sue and be sued in its corporate name and may	
7	hold, acquire and dispose of any property movable or immovable;	
8.	(c) The Institute may with the approval of its supervising	
9	Ministry/Board enter into association/agreement with the competent	
10	authorities of any university or other institution of higher learning or	
11	recognized international institutions for the purpose of promoting or	
12	furthering mutual co-operation in the field of scientific research in respect of	
13	which the Board has responsibility under this Order;	
14	(d) The Institute may, at the written request of any government	
15	agency, local government authority or private body, and if the institute have	
16	resources to meet such request, train laboratory, extension and other	
17	categories or descriptions of workers relative to their specified fields of

20	(e) Without prejudice to the specified research function of the	
21	Institute, the Institute shall produce improved seedlings and other planting	
22	materials primarily for their research and experimental programmes but	
23	may, for the purpose of advancing or disseminating the results of their	
24	researches, make available for distribution to farmers the improved	
25	seedlings and planting materials;	
26	(f) The Institute shall, when so requested by any government in the	
27	Federation, government agency, local government authority or any	-
28	authorized body, provide information or give advice relating to their	
29	specified fields of research to such government, government agency, local	

government authority or authorized body.

Funds of the
Institute

12(1) The Institute shall maintain a fund which	shall be applied
towards the carrying out of its functions.	

- (2) The Institute shall generate internal revenue, which shall be shared at the ratio of 75% -25% for the Institute and Government respectively. The 75% share for the Institute shall be expended on areas that would promote the Institute's mandates.
- (3) There shall be paid and credited into the fund established pursuant to sub-section (I) of this section:
- (i) all fees and other monies payable to the Institute in pursuance of this Bill;
- (ii) all grants, aids, loans and solicited funds received for the Institute;
- (iii) proceeds from programmes/activities;
- (iv) money borrowed from time to time for the purpose of executing programmes of the Institute;
- (v) proceeds from any investment in securities created or issued by or on behalf of the Government of the Federation or any other securities in Nigeria approved by the Board.
- (4) There shall be paid out of the fund:

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- (a) all expenditure incurred by the Institute in the discharge of its functions under the Bill;
- (b) any interest payable on monies borrowed for the activities of the Institute;
- (c) such reasonable travelling and subsistence allowances of the Board, Director General and Staff members in respect of time spent on the duties of the Institute as may be determined by Board/guidelines.
- (5)The Board/Management shall ensure that proper records of income and expenditure of the Institute are kept in respect of each year and accounts audited by registered external auditors shall be submitted to the Auditor General of the Federation each year.

5	SUPPLEMENTARY PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE BOARD AND THE

7	Qualifications and Tenure of Office of members
8	1(i) Subject to the provisions of this paragraph, a member of the
9	Board shall hold office from the effective date of the instrument of his
10	appointment, or of his appointment, as the case may be;
11	(ii)Any member of the Institute who ceases to be a member thereof shall if he is
12	also a member of the Board, cease to hold office on the Board.
13	Powers of the Board
14	2. The Board shall have powers to do anything which in its opinion is
15	calculated to facilitate the carrying-on of the activities of the Institute as
16	stipulated in the Bill.
17	Proceedings of the Board
18	3(i) Subject to the provisions of this Bill, the Board may in the name
19	of the Institute make standing orders regulating the proceedings of the Institute
20	or of the Board, and in the exercise of its powers under this Bill, may set up
21	Committees in the general interest of the Institute and make standing orders
22	therefor;
23	(ii) Standing orders shall provide for decisions to be taken by a
24	majority of the members, and in the event of equality of votes, the Chairman as
25	the case may be has a second or casting vote;
26	(iii) Standing orders made for a Committee shall provide that the
27	Committee is to report back to the Board on any matter not within its
28	competence to decide;
29	(iv) The quorum of the Board shall be four; and the quorum of a
30	Committee of the Board shall be fixed by the Board.

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1	Committees
2	4(i) The Institute may appoint one or more standing or Ad-Hoo
3	Committees to carry out on its behalf such of its functions as it may
4	determine;
5	(ii) A Committee appointed under this paragraph shall consist o
6	such number of persons as may be determined by the Institute; and a person
7	other than a member of the Institute shall hold office on the Committee in
8	accordance with the terms of his appointment;
9	(iii) A decision of a Committee of the Institute shall be of no effec
10	until it is confirmed by the Institute.
11	(a) Meetings of the Institute:
12	5. The Board shall convene the Annual Farming Systems meeting
13	of the Institute every year or on such other date as the Board may from time
14	to time appoint, so however that if the meeting is not held within one yea
15	after the previous annual meeting, not more than fifteen months shall elaps
16	between the respective dates of the two meetings.
17	(b) Meetings of the Board:
18	6(i) The Board shall meet not less than twice in any financia
19	year, and subject to the provisions of any standing orders of the Board, i
20	shall meet at other times as it is summoned by the Chairman; and if the
21	Chairman is required to do so by notice in writing given to him by not les
22	than four other members, he shall summon a meeting of the Board to be held
23	within seven days from the date on which notice is given;
24	(ii) At any meeting of the Board, the Chairman shall preside but in
25	his absence, the members present at the meeting shall appoint one of their
26	numbers to preside at that meeting;
27	(iii) where the Board decides to obtain advice of any person on
28	particular matter, the Board may co-opt him as a member for such period a
29	the Board thinks fit but a person who is a member by virtue of this sub

paragraph shall not be entitled to vote at any meeting of the Board and shall

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1	not count towards a quorum;
2	(iv) Notwithstanding anything in the foregoing provisions of thi
3	paragraph, the first meeting of the Board shall be convened by the Minister
4	who may give such directions as deem fit as to the procedure which shall be
5	followed by the Board.
6	Miscellaneous
7	7. The fixing of the seal of the Institute shall be authenticated by:
8	(i) The Director General of the Institute or officer authorized by the
9	Institute to act in his place for this purpose;
10	(ii) Any contract or instrument which, if made or executed by a persor
11	not being a body corporate would not be required to be under seal may be made
12	or executed on behalf of the Institute or of the Board as the case may require, by
13	any person generally or specially authorised to Act for that purpose by the
4	Board;
5	(iii) Any document purporting to be a document duly executed under
6	the seal of the Institute shall be received in evidence and shall, unless the
7	contrary is proved, be deemed to be so executed.
8	8. The validity of any proceedings of the Institute or of the Board or of
9	a Committee of the Board shall not be affected by any vacancy in membership,
0	or by any defect in the appointment of a member of the Institute or of the Board
1	or of a person to serve on the Committee, or by reason that a person not so
2	entitled to do so took part in the proceedings.

9. Any members of the Institute or of the Board, and any person

holding office on a Committee of the Board, who has a personal interest in any

contract or arrangement being entered into or proposed to be considered by the

Board or any committee thereof, shall forthwith declare and disclose his

interest in such contract or arrangement to the Board/Management and shall be

disqualified to vote on any question relating to such contract or arrangement.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Bill seeks to Repeal the Forestry Research Institute of Nigeria, Act, 1973 and Re-Enact the Forestry Research Institute of Nigeria, Bill, 2015 to enhance and re-focus the Institute to deliver on its mandate
