- 1.-(1) There is established a Commission to be known as North 2 East Development Commission (in this Bill referred to as "the 3 Commission").
 - (2) The Commission shall be a body corporate with perpetual

This Bill seeks to establish North East Development Commission charged with the responsibility among other things to receive and manage fund from allocation of the Federation Account and International Donors for the settlement, rehabilitation and reconstruction of roads, houses and business premises of victims of insurgency as well as tackling menace of poverty, literacy level, ecological problems and any other related environmental or developmental challenges in the North East States.
