AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE NATIONAL FARM SETTLEMENT AND YOUTH EMPOWERMENT AGENCY; AND FOR MATTERS CONNECTED THEREWITH

Sponsored by Senator Matthew A. Urhoghide Commencement BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows-PART I - ESTABLISHMENT OF THE NATIONAL FARM SETTLEMENT AND YOUTH EMPOWERMENT AGENCY 1.-(1) There is established an agency to be known as the National Establishment of the Agency Farm Settlement and Youth Empowerment Agency (in this Act referred to as ("the Agency"). (2) The Agency-(a) shall be a body corporate with perpetual succession and a common seal; and 8 (b) may sue and be sued in its corporate name. 9 (3) The Agency Headquarters shall be located in the Federal 10 Capital Territory, Abuja. (4) The Agency shall maintain operational offices in each State of 12 the Federation, which shall coordinate and establish farm settlements for 13 production of food and cash crops and for the employment and 14 15 empowerment of youths 2.-(1) There shall be established for the Agency, a Governing 16 Governing Board of the Agency Board which shall be responsible for the policy implementation or 17 objectives for the running of the affairs of the Agency (herein after referred 18 19 as "the Board"). (2) The Board shall consist of-20 21 (a) a Chairman;

(2) The Auditor-General or an officer authorized by him is entitled at all reasonable time to a full and free access to all accounts, records, documents and papers of the Agency relating directly or indirectly to the receipt or payment of money by the Agency or to the acquisition, receipt, custody or 4 disposal of assets by the Agency. 16. The Agency shall prepare and submit to the President, through the Annual report 6 Minister of Agriculture, not later than six months after the end of each financial year, a report of the activities of the Agency during the immediate preceding 8 year, and shall include in such report a copy of the audited accounts of the 9 Agency for that year and the Auditor's report on the accounts. 10 17. The Agency may accept any gift, of land, money or other property Power to accept 11 gifts on such terms and conditions, if any, as may be specified by the person or organization making the gift provided that the Agency shall not accept any gift 13 if the conditions attached are inconsistent with the functions of the Agency and 14 the terms of existing laws. 18.-(1) The Agency may, from time to time, borrow such sums as it 16 Power to borrow may require for the performance of its functions under this Act. (2) The Agency shall not, without the approval of the Minister, 18 borrow money which exceeds, at any time, the amount set by the Minister. 20 (3) Notwithstanding Subsections (1) of this section, where the sum to be borrowed is in foreign currency, the Agency shall not borrow the sum 21 without the prior approval of the Minister. 22 23 19. The Agency may, subject to the provisions of this Act and the Investments conditions and the conditions of any trust created in respect of any property, 24 invest all or any of its funds in any security prescribed by the Trustee 25 Investment act or in such other securities as may, from time to time, be 26 approved by the Board. 27 Non-exemption 28 20. The Agency shall not be exempted from the payment of income from tax tax on any income accruing from investments made by the Board for the 29 **30** Agency or otherwise howsoever.

15	civil or criminal, in which judgment is given in his favour or in which he is	
16	acquitted, if any such proceeding is brought against him in his capacity as a	
17	member of the Board, the Managing Director, officer or other employee of	
18	the Agency.	
19	25(1) A member of the Board or the Managing Director or any	Secrecy
20	other officer or employee of the Agency shall-	
21	(a) not, for his personal gain, make use of any information which	
22	has come to his knowledge in the exercise of his powers or is obtained by	
23	him in the ordinary course of his duty as a member of the Board or as the	
24	Managing Director, officer or employee of the Agency;	
25	(b) treat as confidential any information which has come to his	
26	knowledge in the exercise of his powers or is obtained by him in the	
27	performance of his duties under this Act;	
28	(c) not disclose any information referred to under paragraph (b) of	
29	this subjection, except where required to do so by a court or in such other	
30	circumstances as may be prescribed by the Board, from time to time.	

(2) Any person who contravenes the provisions of Subsection (1) of this section commits an offence and is liable on conviction to a fine of not less than N20,000.00 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding two years or to both such fine and imprisonment. 4 26. The Agency may establish farm settlements in each of the 774 Local farm settlements Local Government Areas of the Federation of Nigeria. 6 27.-(1) The statutory functions, rights, interest, obligations and Savings and transitional provisions 8 liabilities of the department responsible for farm settlements, if any, before the 9 commencement of this Act under any contract or instrument by virtue of this Act shall be deemed to have been assigned and vested in the Agency. 10 (2) All assets, funds resources and any other movable or immovable 11 property which immediately before the commencement of this Act, were 12 13 vested in the department responsible for federal farm settlements, if any, shall be vested in the Agency. 14 15 (3) Any person who immediately before the coming into force of this Act is the holder of any office in the department responsible for federal farm 16 17 settlements, if any, shall continue in office and be deemed to have been appointed to the office by the Agency. 18 Power to make 19 28. The Board may, with the approval of the Minister of Agriculture regulations make such regulations as in its opinion are necessary or expedient for giving 20 full effect to the provisions of this Act and for the due administration of its 21 provisions. 22 29. In this Act except the context otherwise requires-Interpretation 23 "Agency" means the National Farm Settlements and Youth Empowerment 24 Agency established by Section 1 of this Act; 25 "Board" means the Governing Board established for the Agency by Section 2 26 of this Act; 27 "Farm Settlements" means the outfit and or unit office or farms established by 28 the Agency in agricultural lands set up by the Agency in States and Local 29

Government Areas of the Federation for the purpose of producing food and cash crops; "Function" includes Power and Duty; "Geopolitical Zones" mean the geopolitical units of the Federation; 4 "Minister" means the Federal Minister in charge of Agriculture; "Ministry" shall be construed accordingly; 6 "President" means the President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria; "Power" includes functions and duty; and "Youth" means young and able-bodied Nigerians. 9 30. This Act may be cited as the National Farm Settlements and 10 Citation Youth Empowerment Agency (Establishment, etc.) Bill, 2016.
