AN ACT TO AMEND THE MARRIAGE ACT M6 TO PROHIBIT THE MARRYING OF MINORS AND FOR OTHER MATTERS CONNECTED THEREWITH

Sponsored by Senator David Umaru Commencement BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: 1. The Marriage Act Cap M6 LFN 2004 (hereinafter simply Amendment of the Marriage Act CAP M6 LFN, referred to as the "Principal Act") is hereby amended and set out in this Bill 2004 as follows: Amendment of 2. This Bill may be cited as the Marriage (Amendment) Bill, 2016. Section 1 (Short Title) 3. Section 2 is amended by introducing two new paragraphs with Amendment of Section 2 the words" Marriage shall mean the union for life of a man and a woman who 6 (Interpretation) has attained full age and capacity, to the exclusion of others". "Full age shall mean the same as prescribed under the Nigerian Child Rights Act" 8 Amendment of Section 18-20 4. Section 18 -20 is deleted and the Principal Act is renumbered 9 (Consent of Marriage in certain sequentially 10 cases necessary) 5. Section 48 is deleted and a new section 48 is introduced with the Amendment of Section 48 words "MARRYING A MINOR- whoever agrees to marry a minor or 12 marries a minor or causes a minor to be married to another is guilty of an 13 offence and is liable to imprisonment of 5 years. 14 EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to prohibit minors from validly contracting a marriage.
