9	SUPPLEMENTARY PROVISION RELATING TO THE BOARD, ETC.
10	1(1) At any meeting of the Board, the Chairman shall preside and in
11	his/her absence, such member of the Board as the other members may elec
12	from among themselves for that purpose.
13	(2) The Director-General shall be the Secretary; and shall provide
14	secretariat services for all meetings of the Governing Board.
15	(3) Subject to this Bill and section 27 of the Interpretation Act, the
16	Board may make standing orders regulating its proceeding or those of any of it
17	Committees.
18	2. The Quorum of the Board shall be the four (4) members of the
19	Board.
20	3. The Board may appoint one or more Committees to carry out, or
21	behalf of the Board, such of its functions as the Board may determine, but no
22	decision of any such Committee shall have effect unless ratified by the Board.
23	4. The Board may co-opt persons who are not members of the Board
24	to any meeting of the Board or any Committee and such persons may take par
25	in the deliberations of the Board or any Committee but shall not be entitled to
26	vote.
27	5. The fixing of the seal of office shall be authenticated by the
28	Signature of the Chairman or any other member of the Board generally or
29	specifically authorized by the Board to act for that purpose and the Director
30	General-

i	(a) a document purporting to be a document duly executed under

2	the seal of NABRO shall be received in evidence and shall, unless and until
3	the contrary is proved, be presumed so executed.
4	6. The validity of any proceedings of the Board or a Committee
5	shall not be adversely affected by-
6	(a) the validity in the membership of the Board or Committee;
7	(b) a defect in the appointment of a member of the Board or
8	Committee; or
9	(c) reason that a person not entitled to do so, took part in the
10	proceeding of the Board or Committee.

This Bill seeks to establish an Independent National Assembly Budget and Research Office, which shall provide the National Assembly with objective, timely and non-partisan analysis needed for economic and budget decisions.
