FOR OTHER RELATED MATTERS 2016 Sponsored by Senator Dinomelaye Senator Obinna Ogba Commencement ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows-1. The National Lottery Act 2005 (in this Bill referred to as "the Amendment of the Lottery Act 2005 principal Act") is amended as set out in this Bill; 2. The Principal Act is amended by substituting the words "National Lottery" and " any Lottery" with the words " Lottery" wherever they appear instead thereof. 3. - licensee's collection agents;

- a certain percentage of Proceeds is to be paid.
