AN ACT TO AMEND THE NATIONAL PROCUREMENT ACT TO PROVIDE FOR AND ADOPT A LOCAL CONTENT POLICY AND TIMELY COMPLETION OF PROCUREMENT PROCESSES; AND OTHER RELATED MATTERS

Commencement ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: 1. The Public Procurement Act, Cap. P, LFN, 2004 (hereinafter Amendment of the Procurement Act, No. 2005 referred to as the Principal Act) is amended as set out in this Bill. 2. Section 15 (1) of the Principal Act is amended by substituting Amendment of Section 15 for subsection (1) thereof a new subsection, that is: 4 Subject to the provisions of the infrastructure Concession Regulatory Commission (ICRC) Act, the provisions of this Act shall apply to all 6 procurement of goods, works and services carried out by: 8 (a) the Federal Government of Nigeria and all procurement entities 9 (b) all entities outside the foregoing description which derive at 10 least thirty-five per cent of the funds appropriated or proposed to be 11 appropriated for any type of procurement described in this Act from the 12 Federation share of Consolidated Revenue Fund". 13 3. Sections 34 (1) and (2) of the Principal Act is amended by Amendment of Section 34 substituting the existing subsections (1) and (2) with new subsections (1) 14 15 and (2) as follows: (1) A procuring entity shall grant a margin of preference in the 16 17 evaluation of tenders, when comparing tenders from domestic bidders with those from foreign bidders or when comparing tenders from domestic 19 suppliers offering goods manufactured locally with those offering goods 20 manufactured abroad.

- (2) Where a procuring entity has allowed domestic preferences, the bidding documents shall clearly indicate any preference to be granted to domestic suppliers and contractors and the information required to establish the eligibility of a bid for such preference.
- (3) Margins of preference shall apply only to tenders under international competitive bidding. 6
 - (4) The Bureau shall by regulation from time to time set the limits and the formulae for the computation of margins of preference and determine the contents of goods manufactured locally.

Amendment of Section 35

- 4. Section 35 of the principal Act is amended by substituting for subsection (1) thereof a new subsection, that is:
- "(1) In addition to any other regulations as may be prescribed by the Bureau, a mobilization fee of not more than 35% may be paid to a supplier or contractor supported by the following:
