## A BILL

## FOR

AN ACT TO GIVE FORCE OF LAW TO RESOLUTIONS PASSED BY BOTH HOUSES OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY AND FOR MATTERS CONNECTED THEREWITH

Sponsored by Senator Ibrahim Gobir

] Commencement

BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows:

1.-(1) Subject to the provisions of the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria and the rules of both Houses of the National Assembly, a resolution on any subject on which the National assembly is empowered to legislate, shall be complied with and have binding effect on any Person/Persons, entity, authority, department, agency of government, their agents/ privies to whom the resolution may be addressed, where such a resolution is passed by both Houses of the National Assembly.

- (2) A motion for a resolution referred in subsection (1) above, may originate in and passed by both Houses or originate in and passed by either House and communicated to the other House of the National Assembly for concurrence.
- (3) A resolution so passed by both Houses of the National Assembly shall be communicated to the Person/Persons, authority, entity or agency concerned for compliance, within the time specified therein.
- 2. Any person/persons, authority, entity/agency who fails, neglects, refuses to comply, and condones or abets non- compliance with a resolution passed in accordance with section (1) above, shall be issued with a query and an ultimatum to comply within another period of 14 days by the Clerk of the National Assembly.
  - 3.-(1) If after the 14 days period given in section 2 above, he

refuses, fails, neglects to comply, and condones or abets non-compliance, the person shall be deemed to have committed an act of gross misconduct; and (2) In case of an elected political office-holder, shall be liable to trial as contained in the constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria and other 4 relevant enactments. 5 (3) In case of any other person/persons, entity/organization, shall be 6 deemed to have ceased to be a fit and proper person to hold any public and corporate office of trust and responsibility in 1\igeria and stand dismissed from 8 his present office and remains so disqualified for a period of 5 years; provided 9 that where an entity commits an offence of non-compliance, the Chief 10 Executive and Directors of the entity by any name whatsoever called, shall be liable to the penalties stipulated under this Act. 4. Where a resolution demands compliance with a policy/activity 13 direction on any issue, on sustainable basis, the penalties stipulated under this Act shall apply at any time a case of non-compliance is brought to the attention 15 of the Clerk, provided that any member of the National Assembly or its Committee shall have the right to bring a case of non-compliance to the attention of the Clerk. 18 5.
