EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

(This does not form part of the above Act, but it is intended to explain its purport)

This Bill seeks to amend the Federal Polytechnics Act (CAP F17, LFN, 2004) to among other things-review the retirement age of staff of Federal polytechnics in Nigeria and to harmonize the tenure of the office of the Rector and other principal officers of the Federal Polytechnics in Nigeria.

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
