Commencement ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria: PART 1 - ESTABLISHMENT AND FUNDING OF PRESIDENTIAL 1 INAUGURATION COMMITTEE 2 1.-(1) There is established a Committee to be known as the Pstablishment of presidential 3 Presidential Transition Committee (in this Bill referred to as "the transition 4 Committee").
