AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE NORTH EAST DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION IN THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF NIGERIA TO ADDRESS THE DEVASTATION CAUSED BY INSURGENCY AND OTHER CONNECTED MATTERS

Sponsored by Senator Kabiru Gaya Commencement ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: PART I — ESTABLISHMENT, ETC. THE NORTH EAST DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION AND GOVERNING BOARD 1.—(1) There is hereby established a body to be known as the Establishment of the North East North East Development Commission (in this Act referred to as "the Development 4 Commission Commission"). (2) The Commission— 6 (a) shall be a body corporate with perpetual succession and a common seal; 8 (b) may sue and be sued in its corporate name. (3) The Commission shall have its head office in Maiduguri, Borno 10 State and shall establish an office in each member State of the Commission. 11 (4) The President may subject to the approval of the National 12 Assembly wind-up the Commission after 10 years. 13 2.—(1) There is hereby established for the Commission a Establishment of 14 Government Governing Board (in this Act referred to as "the Board"), which shall consist Council of the 15 Commission of— 16 (a) a chairman; (b) one person who shall be an indigene to represent each the 18 following member States, that is-19 (i) Adamawa, 20

Tenure of office	19	3.—(1) Subject to the provisions of section 4 of this Act a member of

	21	years at the first instance and may be reappointed for a further term of 4 years

20	practicing his profession in any part of the world by an order of a competent	
21	authority made in respect of that member; or	
22	(f) he resigns his appointment by a letter addressed to the President,	
23	Commander-in-Chief of the Armed Forces	
24	(3) Where a vacancy occurs in the membership of the Board, it	
25	shall be filled by the appointment of a successor to hold office for the	
26	remainder of the term of office of his predecessor, so however, that the	
27	successor shall represent the same interest and shall be appointed by the	
28	President, Commander-in-Chief of Armed Forces subject to the	
29	confirmation of the Senate.

•	21	ensure sound and efficient management of the resources of the North East;
	22	(f) carry out such other functions as the President may, from time to
	23	time, direct.
	24	(2) In exercising its functions and powers under this section, the
	25	Commission shall have regard to the varied and specific contributions of each
	26	member state of the Commission.


