## A BILL

## **FOR**

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR CONSTITUENCY PROJECT IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE FEDERATION AND FOR OTHER MATTERS CONNECTED THEREWITH

Sponsored by Senator Stella Oduah

ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: 1. As from the commencement of this Act, there shall be a Establishment of 1 Constituency provision for Constituency Projects in the Annual Budget of the Federation Projects 2 by a minimum of 20%. 3 2. The provisions of this Act shall apply, as more specifically Object and 4 nurpose of the provided for in the Act, and shall ensure that specific portion of the Federal 5 annual budget is devoted to the constituencies for the purposes of 6 infrastructural development, wealth creation and the fight against poverty at 7 the constituency level. 8 3.-(1) The list of proposed Constituency Projects to be covered by Submission of 9 Constituency this Act shall be submitted by the member of the National Assembly proposals 10 representing that Constituency. 11 (2) The member shall submit the project proposal to the 12 Appropriation Committee for input into the budget. 13 4.-(1) The list of projects shall be submitted on Standard Submission 14 form Constituency Projects submission form set out in the Schedule to this Bill. 15 (2) All projects to every Constituency shall be listed in the Form 16. together with the amount allocated to such project. 17 5. For every project listed in the form there shall be attached a 18 Description Form Standard Project Description Form set out in the Schedule to this Act. 19
