AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT AND INCORPORATION OF NATIONAL POSTGRADUATE COLLEGE OF MEDICAL LABORATORY SCIENCE PROVISION FOR ITS DUE ADMINISTRATION

Sponsored by Senator Lanre Tejuoso

ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: 1 1.-(a) There is hereby established a National postgraduate college of Medical laboratory Science (in this Act referred to as "the college"); 2 (b) The college shall be a body corporate with perpetual succession 3 4 and a common seal and may sue or be sued in its corporate name; (c) The headquarters of the college shall be situated in the Federal 5 Capital Territory of Nigeria or any other location deemed fit. 6 7 2.-(a) The college shall have responsibility for the conduct of professional postgraduate examination of candidates in the various 8 specialised branches of medical laboratory science and make awards in 9 10 relation thereto accordingly; 11 (b) To promote sound moral principles, ethics, national unity, 12 excellence and services: 13 (c) To relate its activities to the social, cultural and economic needs 14 of the people of Nigeria; 15 (d) To develop technologically advanced, academic and student 16 service. 3.-(1) The College shall consist of all Fellows of the College and its 17 18 affairs shall be managed by: Burney Commence of the Service (a) A Governing Board; and 19

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1.	(b) A Senate. This shall exercise such powers as are conferred on it by
2	this Act.
3	(2) The supplementary provisions in the schedule to this Act shall
4	have effect with respect to the proceedings of the Governing Board and the
5	Senate and the other matters therein mentioned.
6	4. The Governing Board of the college shall consist of:
7	(a) The President of the College who shall be the Chairman;
8	(b) The Chairman and Registrar of the Medical Laboratory Science
9	Council of Nigeria;
10	(c) Twelve representatives of the Senate;
11	(d) The Federal Director of Medical Laboratory Service;
12	(e) The Permanent Secretary, Federal Ministry of Health or his
13	representative;
14	(f) Then Permanent secretary, Federal Ministry of Finance or his
15	representative;
16	(g) The Permanent Secretary, Federal Ministry of Education or his
17	representative;
18	(h) The Permanent Secretary, Federal Ministry of Science and
19	Technology or his representative;
20	(i) Two representatives of the Association of Medical Laboratory
21	Scientists of Nigeria.
22	5. The Governing Board shall be the governing body of the College
23	and shall be charged with the general control and superintendence of the policy,
24	finances and property of the College, including its public relations.
25	6. The Senate shall consist of:
26	(a) The president of the College who shall be Chairman;
27	(b) The Chairman and Secretary of each Faculty7 board appointed in
28	line with section 9 of this Act; and
29	(c) One representative elected by each Faculty.
30	7. The Senate shall have responsibility for the running of the

1	academic affairs of the College including:
2	(a) The organization and control of courses of study at the college
3	and of the examination held in connection with those courses;
4	(b) The award of followships, diplomas and such other
5	qualifications as may be prescribe in connection with examinations held as
6	aforesaid.
7	8(1) subject to paragraph 1 of the schedule to this Act, the
8	president shall be appointed by the Governing Board and shall hold office as
9	such for three years.
10	(2) In the event of the death or incapacity of the President or if for
11	any reason other than the effluxion of time the office of president is vacant,
12	the Governing Board shall appoint another person as President for the
13	residue of the term of the President.
14	(3) Members of the Governing Board appointed under paragraph
15	(b) of section 4 above and members of the senate appointed under paragraph
16	(b) and (c) of section 6 above shall hold for three years.
17	(4) Any of the members of the Governing Board or the Senate
18	referred to in subsection (3) of this section may by notice to the Governing
19	Board or, as the case may be, to the Senate resign his appointment, and
20	where any such member ceases to hold office before his term of office would
21 ·	have expired by effluxion of time, the body practicable appoint or as the case
22	may be, elect a person to fill the vacancy for the residue of term aforesaid.
23	9(1) Each Faculty shall comprise all Fellows in the appropriate
24	speciality and faculties in the College shall be as follows, that is to say:
25	(a) The Faculty of Clinical Chemistry;
26 ·	(b) The Faculty of Medical Bacteriology and Mycology;
27	(c) The Faculty of Haematology and Blood Transfusion Science;
28	(d) The Faculty of Cellular Pathology/Histoscience;
29	(e) The Faculty of Medical Parasitology and Entomology;
30	(f) The Faculty Diagnostic Molecular Biology;

1	(g) The Faculty of Immunology;
2	(h) The Faculty of Medical Virology;
3	(i) The Faculty of Cytogenetic;
4	(j) The Faculty of Forensic Science;
5	(k) The Faculty of Biomedical Technology/Instrumentation;
6.	(1) The Faculty of General Medical Laboratory Practice;
7	(m)The Faculty of any other speciality as may be prescribed by the
8	Governing Board of the College.
9	(2) Each Faculty shall elect from among its member not less than 7 but
10	not more than 15 persons to serve as its Faculty Board, two of such persons
11	being elected Chairman and Secretary respectively of the Faculty Board. Al.
12-	members so elected shall hold for a period of three years.
13	(3) Subject to such standing orders that may be made by the Senate for
14	that purpose, each Faculty Board may carry out its duties as it deem fit.
15	(4) Each Faculty shall appoint a court of examiners and the court shall
16	be charge with the conduct of examinations under this section. Thereafter the
17	Faculty Board shall make its recommendations to the Senate.
18.	(5) Members of a Faculty Board shall not be entitle to any emolument
19	other than expenses reasonably incurred in travelling on Board's business, but
20	members of a court of examiners shall be entitle to such remuneration as the
21	Governing Board of the College may authorise.
22	10. Where a candidate offers himself for examination under this Act
23	he/she shall satisfy the appropriate Faculty Board:
24	(a) That he/she is a registered medical laboratory scientist with a
25	current practising license; and
26	(b) That he/she is in possession of and is therein named as the holder
27	of a certificate from an institution recognised by the College showing that
28	he/she has satisfactorily attended the prescribed period of the course.
29	11. Where the College awards its Fellowship under this Act the
30	holder shall be entitle to status as a Fellow in the specialised branch of which

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1	the Fellowship is awarded.	
2	12. The College may on the recommendation of the Senate award	
3	honorary Fellowship to persons of distinction in the community who need	
4	not be medical laboratory scientists, and without prejudice to subsection (2)	
5	below may on the like recommendation elect Fellows who need not have	
6	offered themselves for any post-graduate examination conducted by the	
7	College.	
8	(2) No person shall be eligible for election as a fellow unless he/she	
9	already possesses a degree or other qualification registered with the Medical	
10	Laboratory Science Council of Nigeria and satisfies such other condition as	
11	may be prescribed by the College.	
12	13. The College shall from time to time publish in the Federal	
13	Gazettes and elsewhere as it may think fit:	
14	(a) Particulars of the standards which are to be treated as sufficient	
15	for the purposes of examinations conducted by the Colleg pursuant to this	
16	Act;	
17	(b) The list of institutions recognised for purposes of section 10 of	
18	this Act.	
19	14(1) the Governing Board may employ such staff of the College	
20	as it may consider necessary for the purpose of any of the functions	,
21	conferred on anybody under this Act.	
22	(2) The Governing Board shall from among the officers appointed	
23	to subsection (1) of this section select a person to act its Registrar and as	
24	Secretary to the Senate.	
25	15(1) in this Act:	Interpretation
26	"the College" means the postgraduate College of Medical Laboratory	
27	Science established by section 1 of this Act;	
28	"Faculty Board" means any Faculty Board established by or pursuant to	
29	section 9 of this Act;	
30	"the Medical Laboratory Science Council" means the Medical Laboratory	

	1	Science Council of Nigeria;
	2	"the President" means the President of the College;
	3	"the Senate" means the Senate of the College referred to in section 3 of this Act;
	4	(2) Unless the context otherwise requires expressions used in this Act
	5	have the same meaning as in the Act.

	14	1(1) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this Act, the
	15	persons who immediately before the commencement of this Act were Fellows
	16	of the Medical Laboratory Council of Nigeria shall on the commencement of
	17	this Act become members of the corresponding Faculty Boards for purposes of
	18	this Act and shall be deemed to have been appointed pursuant to section 9 of
	19	this Act.
	20	(2) Appointments of members of Faculty Boards shall be made in
	21	accordance with the provisions of section 9 of this Act.
•	22	(3) Each Faculty shall elect the first representative of the
	23	corresponding Faculty on the Senate as specified in section 6 (c) of this Act.
	24	(4) The first meeting of the Senate shall be summoned by the
	25	President of the Council and shall be presided over by him. At this meeting the
	26	Senate shall elect the person to be recommended to the Governing Board for
	- 27	appointment as the first President of the College as well as the first twelve
	28	representatives of the Senate on the Governing Board as specified in section 4
	- 29	(c) of this Act.
	30	(5) The first meeting of the Governing Board shall be called by the

1	President of the Council and shall be presided over by him until the		
2	President of the College is appointed in the manner prescribed in section 8		
3	(1) of this Act.		
4	Proceedings of the Governing Board, Senate, etc.		
5	2(1) The Governing Board may make standing orders regulating		
6	its proceedings or of any committee of the Board.		
7	* (2) The Senate may make standing orders regulating its		
8	proceedings or of any Faculty		
9	Board or of any committee of the Senate		
10	3. The quorum:		
11	(a) of the Governing Board shall be 7;		
12	(b) of the Senate shall be 14;		
13	(c) of any Faculty Board shall be determined by the Senate.		
14	4. At any meeting of the Governing Board or the Senate the		
15	President shall preside and if the President is absent the members present		
16	shall elect one of their numbers to preside at the meeting.		
17	Committees of the Governing Board and Senate		
18	5(1) the Governing Board may appoint one or more committees		
19	to carry out on behalf of the Board such of its functions as the Board may		
20	determine but a decision of a committee shall be of no effect until it is		
21	confirmed by the Board.		
22	(2) The Senate may appoint one or more committees to carry out on		
23	behalf of the Senate such of its functions as the Senate may determine but a		
24	decision of a committee shall be of no effect until it is confirmed by the		
25	Senate.		
26	Miscellaneous		
27	6(1) The fixing of the seal of the College shall be authenticated by		
28	the signature of the President or of some other member authorised generally		
29	or specially by the Governing Board for that purpose.		
20	(2) Any contract or instrument which, if made or executed by		

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- person not being a body corporate, would not be required to be under seal may
 be made or executed on behalf of the College by any person generally or
 specially authorised to act for that purpose by the Governing Board.
 - (3) Any document purporting to be a document duly executed under the seal of the College shall be received in evidence and shall, unless the contrary is proved, be deemed to be so executed.
 - 7. the validity of any proceedings of the Governing Board, the Senate or-any Faculty Board or of a committee of the Governing Board or the Senate shall not be affected by any vacancy in the membership of the body concerned or by any defect in the appointment of any member or by reason that a person not entitled to do took part in the proceedings.
 - 8. Any member of the Governing Board, and any person holding office on a committee of the Board, who has a personal interest in any contract or arrangement entered into or proposed to be considered by the Board and shall not vote on any question relating to the contract or arrangement.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note not form part of the above Act but is intended to explain its purport)

This Act establishes a National Postgraduate College of Medical Laboratory Science and charges it with responsibility for the conduct of professional medical laboratory science. The College is to consist of a Governing Board, which will be the governing body of the College; a Senate, which will have responsibly for the conduct of examinations.
