AN ACT TO ALTER THE CONSTITUTION OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF NIGERIA 1999 (AS AMENDED) BY DELETING THE PROVISO TO S215 (4) AND REMOVING THE OUSTER PROVISION OF DIRECTIONS GIVEN TO THE POLICE ON COMBATING CRIME UNDER SECTION 215(5) OF THE CONSTITUTION

Commencement ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria: 1. The Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria 1999 (in Amendment of 1 the Constitution this Bill referred to as "the Principal Act") is altered as set out in this Bill. 2 2. Section 215 of the Principal Act is altered by: Amendment of 3 Section 215 of Principal Act (a) deleting the provision to subsection 4; (b) deleting immediately after the word "shall" in line 3, the word 5 "not"; in subsection 5. 6 3. This Bill is cited as Constitution of the Federal Republic of 7 Citation Nigeria 1999 (Alteration) Bill, 2016. 8 EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to Alter the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria 1999 (As Amended) by deleting the Proviso to S215 (4) and removing the ouster provision of directions given to the Police on combating crime under section 215(5) of the Constitution.
