Commencement BEITEACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: 1. The Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria 1999 (in Alteration of the 1 Principal Act this Bill referred to as "the Principal Act") is altered in the manner 2 hereinafter set out in this Bill. 3 2. Section 162(1) of the Principal Act is altered by the creation of a Alteration of 4 Section 162(1) new section 162(1) A as follows: 5 162 (1) A - (i) There shall be for the Federation an Accountant -6 General who shall, to the exclusion of the Accountant - General of the 7 Federal Government, maintain, manage and operate the Federation Account 8 and the Excess Revenue Account of the Federation created and established 9 by this section and any other Pool Accounts of the Federation by whatever 10 name so called; 11 (ii) The Accountant -General for the Federation shall be appointed 12 by the President on the recommendation of the Council of State subject to 13 confirmation by the Senate; 14 (iii) The power to appoint persons to act in the office of the 15 Accountant-General for the Federation shall vest in the President; 16 (iv) Except with the sanctions of a resolution of the Senate, no 17 person shall act in the office of the Accountant-General tor the Federation 18

(v) A person holding the office of the Accountant-General for the
Federation shall be removed from the office by the President acting on address
supported by two-thirds majority of the Senate praying that he be so removed
for inability to discharge the functions of his office (whether arising from
infirmity of mind or body or any other cause) or for misconduct.

3. This Bill may be cited as the Constitution Alteration Bill, 2016.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to alter the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, 1999 in section 162 (1) to provide for the Office of Accountant-General for the Federation.
