This Bill may be cited as the Compulsory, Free, Universal Basic Citation 9 Education Act, 2004 (Amendment) Bill, 2016. 10 EXPLANATORY NOTE This Bill seeks to amend the Compulsory, Free, Universal Basic Education Act, 2004 to increase the block grant contribution of the Federal Government while reducing those of the State Governments. This is aimed at redressing the current situation where most States are unable to access the grant owing to their inability to contribute the 50% of the total cost of the project as its commitment in its execution.
