AN ACT TO AMEND THE NATIONAL LIBRARY ACT CAP N56 LAWS OF THE FEDERATION 2004 AND FOR OTHER MATTERS CONNECTED THEREWITH.

Sponsored by Senator 'Biodun Christine Olujimi Commencement BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: Amendment of 1. The National Library Act Cap N56 Laws of the Federation 2004 Cap N56 LFN, 2004 (In this act referred to as "The Principal Act") is amended as set out in this bill. Amendment of 2. Section 2 of the Principal Act is amended: 4 Section 2 (1) In subsection (1) by inserting the words "National Library" before the word "Board" in line 1. 6 (2) In subsection (2) by substituting for the existing subsection (2) the following new subsection: 8 (a) to act as a national depository institution for books and other 9 research materials in Nigeria; 10 (b) to act as the focal institution and advisory body to individual, corporate and Government institutions on library and information matters; 12 (c) to acquire, process, organize, disseminate as well as provide 13 links to information resources to Nigerians and non-Nigerians alike, for 14 their educational pursuit and for informed decision making; 15 (d) to assemble and maintain a collection of all books, periodicals, 16 newspapers, maps, gazettes, Acts, Laws, Bye-Laws, all subsidiary 17 legislations, notices, orders and other government publications which are 18 published in Nigeria; 19 (e) to assemble and maintain a collection of all musical recording 20 and films produced in Nigeria;

1	(f) to establish and maintain the National Library and Information		
2	Service Centre in each of the six geo-political zones of the federation;		
3	(g) to develop networks and linkages with other libraries in Nigeria		
4	and anywhere in the world;		
5	(h) to prepare catalogues, indexes and similar research aids;		
6	(i) to make the facilities of the National Library and Information		
7	Service Center available to members of the public and others on proper terms		
8	which may includes provision for:		
9	(i) registration of persons admitted to use the library facilities;		
10	(ii) the imposition of fees for services rendered to the public; and		
11	(iii) safe - guarding the property of the Board.		
12	(j) to provide consultancy services to individuals, communities,		
13	corporate bodies, agencies and other government bodies wishing to establish		
14	libraries;		
15	(k) to develop the national bibliography of Nigeria and national		
16	bibliography centre or elsewhere;		
17	(l) to prescribe the rules and procedure for granting applications for		
18	ISBN/ISSN/NBN/CIP, etc;		
19	(m) to engage in research on any subject of national interest and		
20	publish its findings for public use;		
21	(n) to provide and encourage staff to undertake capacity building and		
22	skill acquisition programmes to enhance their skills in the performance of their		
23	duties to the Board;		
24	(o) to engage in readership campaign with a view to encouraging		
25	readership culture and awareness among Nigerians;		
26	(p) to provide leadership initiative in the area of resource sharing and		
27	library cooperation;		
28	(q) to audit the source of unrecorded information such as indigenous		
29	knowledge which are required for continued research into national origin of		
30	our history and culture;

1	(r) to develop Information and Communications Technologies
2	(ICT) facilities to ensure that the services of the National Library and
3	antormation Service Centre are offered in real time, more widely and more
4	efficiently;
5	(s) to develop a Virtual Library for Nigeria; and
6	(t) to provide in accordance with this Act such services as in the
7	opinion on the Board are usually provided by national libraries all over the
8	world;
9	3. Section 3 of the principal act is amended by substituting for the
10	existing Section 3, the following new Section 3:
11	(1) There shall be a National Librarian who, subject to subsection
12	(2), shall be appointed by the Minister and shall be a person appearing to the
13	Minister to have shown exceptional capacity in the organization and
14	administration of a library and services comparable to those envisaged by
15	this Act.
16	(2) The National Librarian shall hold office for a term of 4 years in
17	the first instance and may be reappointed for a further term of 4 years and no
18	more.
19	(3) Subject to the Board's financial, operational and administrative
20	policy programmes, the National Librarian shall have the general function
21	of organizing and managing the National Library and the services provided
22	in pursuance of this Act, and, in particular, the function of directing the
23	activities of the officers and servants of the Board and managing the Board's
24	financial affairs.
25	(4) Subject to subsection (3), the National Librarian shall be free to
26	manage the National Library as he thinks fit in accordance with this Act, and
27	the Board shall not interfere with the manner in which he deploys the
28	material and human resources of the Board in order to obtain results in

accordance with this Act.

- 4. Section 4 of the principal act is amended by substituting for the existing Section 4, the following new Section 4:
- (1) Every author and publisher of a published work in Nigeria shall within one month after the publication deposit with the National Librarian three copies of the book for permanent preservation and public use.
- (2) Where the publication is by or on behalf of any department of government of the Federation, State or Local Council it shall be the duty of the official in charge of the department to deliver twenty-five copies of the publication to the National Librarian for permanent preservation and public use.
- (3) Where either the author or publisher fails to comply with the provision of subsection (1) of this section, the person in default shall be guilty of an offence and on conviction shall be liable to a fine not exceeding N100,000 or such fines as may be prescribed by the Board from time to time.
- (4) If the defaulter is a corporate body, upon conviction, it shall be liable to a fine not exceeding N1,000,000 only or such fines as may be prescribed by the Board from time to time.
- (5) Without prejudice to subsection (3), the court shall order the person in default to deliver to the National Librarian the mandatory number of copies of the publication.
- (6) The President may by order in the Federal Gazette exclude any publisher or book, or any class of publisher or book, from the operation of subsections (1) and (2) of this section.
- (7)The obligations imposed by this section are additional to any similar obligations which may be imposed by any law or regulation in force in Nigeria under this Act.
- (8) In this Section:
- 28 "book" includes:
- (a) all literary works such as books, pamphlets, sheets of music, maps,
 electronic publications, charts, plans, tables and compilations;

2	(c) collective works such as encyclopedias, dictionaries, year	•
3	books or similar works, newspapers, magazines and similar periodicals;	
4	(d) any work written in distinct parts by different authors or in	
5	which a part or parts of work of different authors is or are incorporated, and	
6	every part or division of such a work; and	
7	(e) all forms in which documentary or oral records are published,	
8	"publisher", in relation to a book, means any person authorizing or causing	
9	the book to be printed and distributed in Nigeria, excluding the Federal	
10	Government and the Governor of a State (or any person acting on its or his	
11	behalf), a public officer acting in his capacity as such and any person	
12	distributing in Nigeria a book published elsewhere.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The bill seeks to amend the National Library Act Cap N56 Laws of the Federation 2004 to among other things provide for:

Strengthening the National Library Board of Nigeria in the performance of its functions under its enabling Act, the provision of adequate sanctions to deal with authors and publishers who default in complying with the deposit of publications and to properly designate the nomenclature of the Director of the National Library as the National Librarian.
