AN ACT TO PRESCRIBE PUNISHMENT FOR ACTS AND CONDUCT THAT ARE UNDEMOCRATIC BY ELECTED OFFICIALS AND OR PERSON AND OTHER MATTERS CONNECTED THEREWITH 2015.

Commencement BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: 1. Any person who knowingly obstruct by the use of force or Obstructing Democratic Process threat, or any other means of a democratic process with intention to derive any benefit by undemocratic means shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to imprisonment for a term not exceeding two years with an order of court barring him from holding any elective office for a period of 12 years or both. 6 2. Any person who being a civil servant and or a security personnel Provision of information to who with intent to circumvent democratic process offers or provide any deray democratic 8 process information the width of which is relied upon to postpone time, date or 9 venue of any democratic process shall be guilty of offence and upon conviction, shall be liable to imprisonment for a term of two year without 11 option of fine. 12 3. Any person who without lawful authority issues any statement Give advantage 13 to any political written or verbal with intention to give advantage to any registered political party 14 party against any or all of the other political parties shall be guilty of an 15 offence and upon conviction shall be liable to a term of imprisonment not 16 exceeding 5 years with a fine of N5,000,000 or both. 17 4. Any person who being a public officer, civil servant and or Obstruction of 18 political parties security personnel who with intention of put a political party or any person 19 contesting an election at a disadvantage, unlawfully obstruct or refuses to 20

grant permit for the use of a public place whether own by the state or the federal government shall be guilty of an offence and upon conviction shall be liable to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 5 years with fine of N2,000,000 or both. 5. Any person who defaces, tears, remove or cause to be removed any 4 Defacement or removal of campaign materials poster, billboard or campaign materials of whatever descriptions shall be guilty of an offence and upon conviction shall be liable to a term of imprisonment for 6 two years with a fine of N2,000,000 or both. 6. Any media print or electronic, television station which accept and Unfair advert 8 air any advertisement from a political party and/or candidate which is intended to unfairly disparage any candidate for an election with intention to give an 10 unfair advantage to a political party and/or candidate of a political party shall 11 be guilty or an offence and upon conviction shall be liable to a term of 12 13 imprisonment of 2 years and a fine of N2,000,000 for each of the slot already aired, printed or circulated and revocation order of the license issued for the 14 15 purpose of its operation. 7. Any person who with intention to disrupt a political process, 16 Disruption of political process meetings, gathering, and/or rallies, does or course to be done any violent act 17 and or conduct himself in an un orderly manner capable of disrupting a lawful 18 assembly of persons shall be guilty of an offence and upon conviction shall be 19 liable to a fine of N2,000,000 or an imprisonment of 2 years or both such fine 20 and imprisonment. 21 8. Any person who knowingly publishes, distributes, circulate or Distribution and 22 circulation of false document course to be published, distributed, and/or circulate any document, pamphlet, 23 banner, posters knowing the contents to be false with intention to course 24 political mischief shall be guilty of. an offence and upon convention shall be 25 liable to a fine of N5,000,000 or an imprisonment for a term of 3 years or both 26 such fine and imprisonment. 27 Citation 9.
