Commencement ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: 1. The Copyright Act in this Act referred to as the "Principal Act" 1 Amendment of Cap. C28, 2004 is hereby amended as set out under this Act. 2 2.-(1) Section 6 of the Principal Act is amended by inserting the 3 Insertion of subsection (1) (d) 4 following new subsection (1) (d) that is-(d) In the case of works on the internet in which Copyright subsists 5 to do or authorize the doing of any of the following acts, that is-6 (i) Post or publish the work on the internet; 7 8 (ii) Sell the work through the internet platform; (iii) Distribute to the public through the internet for commercial purposes, copies of the work, by way of rental, lease, hire, loan or similar 10 11 arrangement. (iv) Make any adaptation of the work. 12 3. (h) (l) and (j) 14 (h) Any work published on the internet including images, sound, 15 print, photo, music, email, web page and links in which copyright subsists is 16 17 protected in accordance with the provisions of this Act.

copyright subsists is infringed upon, the original complaint shall be filed with 1 the Nigerian Copyright Commission prior to any other charges or law suit 2 being filed for such an infringement. 3 (i) Where any work on the internet in which copyright subsists is 4. .. infringed upon, stolen, accessed or copied for commercial purposes contrary to 5 6 the provisions of this Act, the infringer is liable to 3 years imprisonment or a fine not exceeding N10,000,000 (Ten million Naira). 7 8 4. There is inserted, immediately after the existing section 15 (2) (b) 9 of the Principal Act. the following new subsection (2)(c): (2) (c) Internet service providers are protected in accordance with the 10 provisions of this Act, as computer automatically makes a copy of every page 11 visited, which is stored temporarily as RAM or longer as cached page: 12 (i) However, where the internet service provider is aware of a 13 customer infringing upon rights of a work which copyright subsists, the 14 internet service provider must report the customer to the appropriate authority; 15 (ii) Where the internet service provided fails to report such 16 infringement, he shall be as liable as the customer who has infringed on the 17 18 work. 5. There is inserted immediately after the existing section 51 (2) of 19 the Principal Act, the following new subsection (3): 20 "RAM" means Random Access Memory and it is a form of computer data 21. storage which allows stored data to be accessed in any other form. 22

"RAM" means Random Access Memory and it is a form of computer data storage which allows stored data to be accessed in any other form.

"Internet Service Provider" means a company that offers its customer access to the internet. The internet service provider connects to its customers using a data transmission technology appropriate for delivery internet Protocol datagram, such as dial-up, cable modem, wireless or dedicated high-speed interconnects.

"Cache Page" means a snapshot of the majority of web pages collected during crawling of the web and is stored in the search engine. These pages are saved or "cached" as a back-up in case the original page is unavailable.
