	BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal	
	Republic of Nigeria as follows:	
1	1. The Counterfeit and Fake Drugs and Unwholesome Processed	
2	Foods (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act Cap C34 Laws of the Federation	
3	2004 (In this act referred to as "The Principal Act") is amended as set out in	
4	this bill.	
5	2. Section 3 of the Principal Act is amended by substituting for the	Amendment of Section 3
6	existing Subsection (1) the following new sub section (1):	Section 5
7	(1) Any person who commits an offence under:	
8	(a) Section 1 of this Act is liable on conviction to life	
9	imprisonment;	
10	(b) Section 2 (1) of this act, is liable on conviction to a fine not	
11	exceeding N2,000,000 or imprisonment for a term of not less than 4 years or	
12	to both such fine and imprisonment.	
13	3. Section 10 of the Principal Act is amended by substituting for	Amendment of Section 10
14	the existing Section 10 the following new Section (10):	
15	10. Any drug, poison or unwholesome processed food products	
16	seized by a Task Force established by this Act shall be forfeited to the	
17	Federal Government and shall be destroyed by the Agency.	
18	4. Section 10 is amended by inserting immediately after the	Insertion of Section 10
19	existing Section 10 the following new sections:	

1	10A-(1) A person convicted of an offense under this Act shall forfeit
2	to the Federal Government all the assets, money in bank and properties which
3	may have been acquired with the proceeds of the crimes;
4	(2)For the avoidance of doubt and without any further assurance than
5	this Act; all the properties of a person convicted of an offence under this Act
5	and shown to be derived or acquired from such illegal act shall be forfeited to
7	the Federal Government.
3	(3) Where a person is arrested for an offence under this Act, the
)	Agency shall immediately trace and attach all the assets, money in bank and
10	properties of the person acquired as a result of such illegal act and shall
1	thereafter cause to be obtained an interim attachment order by the Court.
12	(4) Where:
13	(a) the assets, money in bank or properties of any person arrested for
4	an offence under this Act has been seized; or
5	(b) any assets, money in bank or property has been seized by the
6	Agency under this Act, the Agency shall cause an application to be made to the
7	Court for an interim order forfeiting the money in bank or property concerned
8	to the Federal Government and the Court shall, if satisfied that there is Prima
9	Facie evidence that the property concerned is liable to forfeiture, make an
0.	interim order forfeiting the money in bank or property to the Federal
1	Government.
2	(5) Where an arrested person is convicted of an offence under this Act,
3	the Agency or any authorized officer shall apply to the Court for the order of
4	confiscation and forfeiture of the convicted persons' assets, money in bank and
5	properties acquired or obtained as a result of the crime already subject to an
6	interim under this Act.
7	(6)(a) A copy of every final order forfeiting the asset, money in bank
8	and property of a person convicted under this Act shall be forwarded to the
