4 6. The center shall be headed by a Director General who shall be
5 responsible for the overall operations of the centre, and shall be equivalent in
6 rank to a permanent Secretary in the public service of the Federation.

7 7. The Director General shall be the Chief Executive Officer of the
8 centre:

9 (i) the Director General shall be appointed by the president on the
10 recommendation of the Minister, the appointment shall be based on
11 professional competence and qualification;

12 (ii) the Director General shall hold office into the first instance for a
13 period of 5 years and may be reappointed for a further period of 5 years and not
14 more than such terms and condition as may be determined, from time to time by
15 the presidency.

16 8. The principal Act as amended by inserting the following New
17 Section 2B and to be re-arranged accordingly:

18 (1) There is hereby established in every geopolitical Zone of the
19 federation citizenship & Leadership training centre (hereafter referred to as
20 the centre).

21 (2) There shall be for a centre a director, who shall be appointed-

22 (a) by the Minister on the recommendation of the centre; and

23 (b) on such terms and condition that may be specified in the letter of
24 his appointment.

25 9. Section 11 of the Principal Act is hereby repealed and reenact as
26 follows:

27 The director General shall be the Chief Executive officer of the
28 centre(s) and shall be charged with the general responsibility for the day to day
29 running and management of the affairs of the centre(s) and in particular shall-

1 (a) direct and regulate the programme of work at the centre and
2 zonal offices;

3 (b) promote research within and outside the centre(s);

4 (c) keep safe custody of all the records of the centre(s);

5 (d) demand and receive from any trainee or any person attending a
6 course at the centre(s) such fees as the Board may from time to time,
7 determine;

8 (e) prepare, collate and present to the board annual and other
9 reports on the progress of work at the centre(s) and on the expenditure or
10 liabilities incurred by the centre; and

11 (f) exercise such power and perform such duties as may be
12 conferred or imposed upon him, from time to time, by the board.

13 10. Section 7 of the Principal Act is hereby amended by inserting a Amendment of
Section 7
14 new "paragraph "K" and to be rearranged accordingly:

15 The board shall not exercise any disciplinary control over the Director
16 General without the approval of the Minister.

17 11. Section 12 (3) of the Principal Act is amended by inserting the Amendment of
Section 12 (3)
18 word "General" after "Director".

19 12. Section 21 of the Principal Act is amended in line 5 to mean Amendment of
Section 21
20 Director General of the centre appointed under section 1 of this Act.

21 13. "Director" in this Act refers to Director of the Centre.

23 14. This Bill may be cited as the Citizenship and Leadership Citation
24 Training Centre (Establishment) Act (Amendment) Bill, 2018.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend the citizenship and Leadership Training Centre to make the centre more effective in its activities, by strengthening the organizational structure and to bring its provisions into conformity with accepted democratic principles and the constitution of the Federal republic of Nigeria.
