INDEPENDENT PROSECUTOR Sponsored by Senator Ben Murray - Bruce Commencement BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: 1.-(1) There is established an office known as "the Office of the Federal Independent Prosecutor (hereinafter referred to as "the Office"). (2) There is established an office known as "the Office of State Independent Prosecutor (hereinafter referred to as "the State Office"). 4 (3) The Office and the State Office shall be bodies corporate with perpetual succession and a common seal. 6 (4) The Office and the State Office may sue and be sued in its corporate name. 8 (5) The Office shall be situated in the Federal Capital Territory, 9 Abuja, and may establish branches in such places as the Federal 10 Independent Prosecutor Coordinator may determine. 11 (6) The State Office shall be situated in each of the 36 state capitals 12 and may establish branches in such places within the state as the State 13 independent prosecutor may determine. 14 2.
