AN ACT TO REPEAL TREATIES (MAKING PROCEDURE, ETC.) ACT, CAP, T20, LAWS OF THE FEDERATION OF NIGERIA, 2004 AND TO RE-ENACT TREATIES (MAKING PROCEDURE) ACT, 2020 AND FOR RELATED MATTERS

Commencement ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: 1 1. The treaty making procedure specified in this Act shall be Treaty making procedure 2 binding and applicable for the making of any treaty between the Federation and any other country. 3 2. All treaties and agreements to be negotiated and entered into for 5 and on behalf of the Federation by any Ministry, government agency or department, body or person, shall be made in accordance with the 6 7 Constitution and with the procedure specified in this Act or as may be 8 modified, varied or amended by an Act of the National Assembly. 9 3. Without prejudice to the generality of the provisions of the 10 Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, 1999 (as amended), all treaties and agreements to be made between the Government of the 11 12 Federation and any other country shall not have the force of law except to the extent to which any such treaty has been enacted into law by the National 13 14 Assembly. 15 4. The National Assembly may make laws for the Federation or any part thereof with respect to matters not included in the Exclusive 16 17 Legislative List for the purpose of making or implementing a treaty. 18 5. A bill for an Act of the National Assembly passed pursuant to

the provisions of sub-section s (3) and (4) of this section shall not be

presented to the President for assent, and shall not be enacted, unless it is 1 ratified by a majority of all the Houses of Assembly in the Federation. 2 6. Treaties and Agreements which deal with mutual exchange of 3 Classification of procedure culture, education and any other facilities shall be ratified by simple majority 4 of the National Assembly. 5 7. Treaties and agreements constituting rules which govern inter-6 state relationship and co-operation in any area of endeavour and which have 7 the effect of altering or modifying existing legislation or which affects the 8 legislative powers of the National Assembly shall be enacted into law. 9 8. Agreements which impose financial, political and social obligation 10 on Nigeria or which are of scientific or technical import shall be enacted into 11 12 law. 9. Approval must first be sought and obtained from the two Houses of Approval of the 13. National Assembly the National Assembly before any Ministry, government agency or 14 department, body or person signs any Treaty or Agreement for and on behalf of 15 the Federation of Nigeria with any other country or foreign based company or 16 foreign body. 17 10. Upon the signing of any treaty or Agreement, the Ministry, 18 Transmission of signed Treaty government agency or department, body or person, who is a party in the Treaty and Agreement 19 or Agreement, shall within the period of one month transmit such Treaty or 20 Agreement to the Federal Ministry of Justice and to the two Houses of the 21 National Assembly. 22 11.-(1) The Federal Ministry of Justice shall be the depository of all 23 Depository of Treaties treaties or agreements entered into between the Federation and any other 24 country or a foreign based company or individual. 25 (2) Accordingly, all treaties entered into between the Government of 26 the Federation and any other country or foreign based company or foreign body 27 by any Ministry, government agency or department, body or person, shall be 28 deposited with the Federal Ministry of Justice for record purposes. 29
