Section 16 of the Principal Act is hereby amended by including 5 Amendment of Section 16(2) a new (b) (c) and (d) in subsection (2) of this section thereby changing (b) to 6 (e), to accommodate other means of funding for the Agency and it shall read 7 8 as follows: 9 16(2)(a) Such sums as may, from time to time be lent or granted to the Agency by the Government of the federation, a State or Local 10 Government for running expenses of the Agency all other assets from time 11 to time accruing to the Agency in the cause of discharging its functions 12 under or pursuant to this Act; 13 14 (b) 1% of Local Government's monthly allocation from the Federal 15 Government for the running expenses of the Agency at the Local 16 Governments; (c) 20% of budgetary provisions on Public Enlightenment of all 17 MDAs for communicating government policies, programs and activities by 18 19 the Agency; (d) 10% of Corporate Social Responsibility budgets of corporate 20

organization carrying out business in Nigeria; and

(e) Such sums as may be collected or received by the Agency from
other sources, either in the execution of its functions or in respect of any
property vested in the Agency or otherwise howsoever.

3. This Bill may be cited as National Orientation Agency Act
(Amendment) Bill, 2020.

## EXPLANATION MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to improve on the meager funding of the National Orientation Agency by providing for other sources of funding to enable the Agency carry out its constitutional duties efficiently.
