BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: 1 1. The Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, 1999 (As Alteration of CFRN, 1999 Altered) (herein referred to as the "Principal Act") is altered as set out in this 2 (As Altered) 3 Bill. 2. Section 291 of the Principal Act is altered: 4 Alteration of Section 291 5 (a) in subsection (1) by: (i) inserting immediately after the word "Appeal" the following 6 7 words "or any other superior court of record", and (ii) deleting the word "seventy" and inserting the word "seventy-8 9 five" instead thereof: 10 (b) by deleting subsection (2); and 11 (c) by renumbering subsections (3) and (4) as subsections (2) and 12 (3).3. This Bill may be cited as the Constitution of the Federal 13 14 Republic of Nigeria (Alteration) Bill, 2020.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to alter Section 291 of the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, 1999 (As Altered) to provide for uniformity in the retirement age of all judicial officers in Nigeria and to increase the mandatory retirement age of judicial officers to seventy-five years.
