{ Commencement

ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows-

 The Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, 1999 (in this Bill referred to as "the Principal Act") is altered as set out in this Bill.

Alteration of the Constitution

2. Substitute for paragraph 22 of Part 1 of the Third Schedule to the Principal Act, a new paragraph "22" -

Alteration of the Third Schedule

"22 The Secretary of the Council shall be appointed by the National Judicial Council on the recommendation of the Federal Judicial Service Commission and shall be a legal practitioner of at least fifteen years post call experience."

3. This Bill may be cited as the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria (Fifth Alteration) Bill No. 25, 2022.
