AN ACT TO AMEND THE NIGERIAN COMMUNICATIONS ACT, CAP N11, LAWS OF THE FEDERATION OF NIGERIA, 2004 TO PROVIDE FOR THE INDEPENDENT MEANS AND PROCEDURE OF REMOVING ITS COMMISSIONERS AND FOR RELATED MATTERS

Sponsored by Hon. Unyime Josiah Idem BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: 1. The Nigeria Communications Act, CAP N11 Laws of the 1 Federation of Nigeria, 2004 (herein after referred to as the "Principal Act") 2 3 is amended as set out in this Bill. 2. Section 10 Subsection (3) of the Principal Act is amended by 4 adding new Subsection (3) to the provisions therein as a new clause to read 5 as follows-. 6 "10 (3). Upon Notice to the affected Commissioner by the 7 President of the intention to suspend or remove him, the President shall set 8 9 up a 5-Man Panel of independent professionals in the industry to review and scrutinize the allegation upon which the Commissioner is being alleged and 10 the Panel shall give him a fair hearing in consideration of the allegation." 11 That the initial Subsection 3 is hereby amended and renumbered as 12 Subsection 4 and thereby amended as follows-13 "The affected Commissioner under subsection (1) of this section 14 15 shall be given a reasonable opportunity to make written submissions in his defense to the Panel within a time period specified in the notice and such 16 time period shall not be less than 14 days from the date of the notice". 17 That the initial Subsection 4 is hereby amended and renumbered as 18 Subsection 5 and thereby amended as follows-19

"The affected Commissioner may, after or within the time period
specified in the notice, submit a written submission to the Panel and the Panel
shall thoroughly consider the submissions and make their independent
findings and recommendation to the President within 14 days of the receipt of
the submission."
3. This Bill may be cited as Nigerian Communication Act
(Amendment) Bill, 2021.
