The Criminal Code Act Cap C38 LFN 2004 (in this Bill referred the Criminal 1 Code Act Cap C38 LFN to as "the Principal Act") is amended as set out in this Bill. 2 2004 2. Section 327 of the Principal Act is hereby amended by Amendment of 3 Section 327 expunging the term "imprisonment for one year" and replacing same with 4 the term "Compulsory Counseling and Community Service for a period not 5 less than six months". 6 3. Section 327 of the Principal Act will now be read as follows: 7 "Any person who attempts to kill himself is guilty of a 8 misdemeanour, and is liable to Compulsory Counseling and Community 9 Service for a period not less than six months". 10 4.
