Commencement ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: PART I - ESTABLISHMENT 1 1.-(1) There is hereby established a Federal College of Nursing. Establishment 2 of the Federal Midwifery and Health Sciences at Isiala-Mbano in Imo State. 24	such other monies as may not immediately be required for current expenditure

26	(k) Print or publish works or undertake services as may be deemed
27	consistent with the objects of the College;
28	(I) Do such other acts and things necessary under this Act for the
29	attainment of the objects of the College or incidental to the powers of the
