AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE FEDERAL CAPITAL
TERRITORY COLLEGE OF NURSING AND MIDWIFERY AND FOR RELATED
MATTERS

BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: PART I - ESTABLISHMENT, POWERS AND FUNCTIONS OF THE COLLEGE 1 1.-(1) There is hereby established for the Federal Capital Territory 2 a College to be known as the FCT College of Nursing and Midwifery. 3 (2) The College shall: 4 (a) have the status of a tertiary institution with rights and privileges 5 of such institutions; and 6 (b) be a body corporate with perpetual succession and a common 7 seal with powers to sue and be sued in its corporate name. 8 2. The objects of the College shall be: Objects of the College (a) to provide training and research in Nursing, Midwifery and 10 other specialties of Nursing leading to the award of Professional 11 Certificates, Diplomas, Degrees and other Post Basic Certificates; 12 (b) to provide avenues for continuing education in Nursing, 13 Midwifery and other specialties of Nursing; and 14 (c) to provide such services that are necessary and incidental to the 15 objects of the College. 16 3.-(1) The College shall be a teaching and examining body and Functions and 17 powers of the shall, subject to the provisions of this Act and the regulations of the College College 18 have powers to: (a) provide rules and conditions under which persons may be 20
