AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE ABUJA GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION SYSTEMS AGENCY AND FOR RELATED MATTERS

Commencement BE IT El ACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria PART I - ESTABLISHMENT, MEMBERSHIP, ETC. 2 1.-(1) There is hereby established, an agency to be known as Abuja Establishment of Geographic Information Systems Agency (in this Act referred to as "the the Agency Agency") to exercise the functions and powers, and pursue the objectives 5 assigned to it by this Act. 6 (2) The Agency shall be a body corporate with perpetual succession and a common seal and may: (a) sue and be sued in its corporate name; and (b) hold, acquire and dispose of any property or interest in property, moveable or immovable. 2.-(1) There is hereby established for the Agency, a Governing 11 Composition and Board which shall consist of: 12 proceedings 13 (a) a Chairman to be appointed by the President upon recommendation of the Minister; 14 15 (b) nine persons who shall be appointed by the Minister as members, each being members of or representing the interests of the 16 17 following: (i) each of the six Area Councils in Abuja; 18 (ii) the Federal Capital Development Authority; and 19 (iii) the Abuja Metropolitan Management Authority; 20 (c) the Director-General of the Agency, who shall also be the 21

  - (d) coordinate geographic information system projects, including overseeing the development and maintenance of base maps and geographic information systems within the FCT;

(e) provide consulting services and technical assistance, and

6	Proceedings of the Agency
7	1. Subject to this Act and section 27 of the Interpretation Act

12	2. If at any time, the office of the Chairman is vacant or the

14	to perform the function of his office, the Board may appoint one of its
15	members to perform such functions for the period of the vacancy in the
16	office of the Chairman and references in this schedule to the Chairman shall
17	be construed accordingly.
18	3. Every meeting of the Board shall be presided over by the
19	Chairman and if the Chairman is unable to attend a particular meeting, the
20	Members present at the meeting shall elect one of their Members to preside

22	4. The quorum at a meeting of the Board shall consist of a
23	Chairman (or in the appropriate case, the person presiding at the meeting
24	pursuant to paragraph 2 of this Schedule) and three other members.
25	5. Where upon any specific issue or occasion, the Board desires to
26	obtain the advice of any person on any particular matter, the Board may co-
27	opt that person to be a member for as many meetings as may be necessary.

17	body corporate, would not be required to be made under seal, may be made or
18	executed on behalf of the Agency by the executive secretary or by any other
19	person generally or specifically authorised by the Board to act for that purpose.
20	10. Any document purporting to be a contract, instrument or other
21	document signed or sealed on behalf of the Agency shall be received in
22	evidence and, unless the contrary is proved, be presumed, without further proof
23	to have been so signed or sealed.
24	11. The validity of any proceedings of the Board or a committee
25	thereof, shall not be adversely affected by:
26	(a) any vacancy in the membership of the Board; or
27	(b) any defect in the appointment of a Member of the Board or
28	committee; or
29	(c) reason that a person not entitled to do so, took part in the
30	proceedings.

1	12. Any Member of the Board or a committee thereof, who has a
2	personal interest in any contract or arrangement entered into or proposed to
3	be considered by the Board or committee, shall forthwith disclose his
4	interest to the Board or committee and shall not vote on any question relating
5	to the contract or arrangement.
